AUTISM NATURE TRAIL (ANT)

The ANT is a one-mile looped main Trail with eight stations at various intervals, offering a range of experiences from quiet engagement to active exploration and adventure.



HUMPHREY NATURE CENTER

The Humphrey Nature Center houses many interactive exhibits that especially highlight the plants and animals, geology and river ecology of Letchworth State Park.




PLAY IN LIVINGSTON

Letchworth State Park encompasses 17 miles of staggeringly sheer gorges, three towering and broad waterfalls, dozens of smaller waterfalls, 66 miles of trails, an abundance of overnight options, and opportunities to explore the park via foot, bike, horse, raft or even hot-air balloon.

LOWER FALLS RECREATION AREA

A newly renovated recreation area near Lower Falls including outdoor ping pong tables, badminton and pickle ball courts, bocce and shuffleboard, as well as a fitness loop.



HIGHBANKS RECREATION AREA

This area includes open space, pavilions, a playground, picnic tables and Harvey Swimming Pool, which offers aquatics programs, lap swimming, free swim, and swimming lessons.

1 AL LORENZ PARK

An 80-acre park nestled between the Genesee River, the Mt. Morris County Campus and Letchworth State Park. Includes parking, restrooms, playgrounds, pavilions and sports fields and courts.

2 FRANCIS BELLAMY MEMORIAL PARK

A park with a playground, baseball fields, basketball courts, gazebo and soccer fields.




3 TUSCARORA PARK

A quiet park with a large field, children's play area, swings, basketball hoop, pavilion and grilling area. Restroom available.



4 VETERANS' PARK

Green space with war memorials along a walking path. Electric vehicle charging stations available.



5 GENESEE VALLEY GREENWAY STATE PARK

A 90 mile recreational trail, a straight, level surface consisting of cinders, gravel and mowed grass. Hiking, biking, cross-country skiing and snowmobiling.



6 SONYEA STATE FOREST

A 922-acre reserve of rustic woods & streams, that features several waterfalls and canyon-like gorge walls used for hiking, camping, hunting & fishing.



7 MOUNT MORRIS DAM & RECREATION AREA

A park near the Mount Morris dam that includes kid's play areas, picnic tables, pavilions, educational signage, a visitor center, free dam tours, and public restrooms.



8 JOHN WESLEY POWELL PARK AND BOAT LAUNCH

Free parking lot with easy access ramp to launch a canoe or kayak into the Genesee River.



9 MMCSO PLAYGROUNDS & OUTDOOR FITNESS CENTER

Mount Morris Central School offers an outdoor fitness center as well as a community walking program and weight room availability.
