LOS CABOS ESSENTIALS

WHERE IS LOS CABOS?

Located at the southernmost tip of Mexico's Baja California Peninsula, Los Cabos is made up of the towns of Cabo San Lucas and San José del Cabo connected by a 30-kilometer corridor. The peninsula reaches into the Sea of Cortez and the deep waters of the Pacific Ocean.



CURRENCY

The official unit of currency is the Mexican peso (MXN). However, the U.S. dollar (USD) is widely accepted.

SAFETY AND SECURITY

Neither the U.S. Department of State, nor the French Ministère de l'Europe et des Affaires Étrangères or the German Auswärtiges Amt have issued any adverse travel advisories for visitors to Los Cabos.

This is a safe destination for all visitors and to ensure it remains that way, Los Cabos has implemented an effective plan, with public and private sectors investing close to \$50 million USD to upgrade security infrastructure, equipment, and personnel. The destination has seen a 96% decrease in security-related incidents year over year, and a 17% record in tourism growth.

BEST TIME TO VISIT

While the weather is beautiful all year long, the best time to visit is from October to May, which coincides with various events, such as the Live Luxe Jazz, Bisbee's Black and Blue Tournament (known as the richest fishing tournament in the world), the Art Walk, the Los Cabos Film Festival and the arrival of the humpback whales from December through April.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

All foreign visitors require a valid passport to enter Mexico. European citizens do not need a visa for visits of fewer than 180 days.



THE LAY OF THE LAND

Los Cabos is a magical land full of contrasts, from breathtaking ocean views, windswept deserts and stunning mountains. The destination is also known as "Land's End" for being located at the southern tip of the Baja California Sur Peninsula. The extraordinary world of Los Cabos is a place of unparalleled natural beauty, biodiversity and ample amenities that will appeal to anyone as it is a stylish heaven in a tropical paradise.

These are the main tourist destinations of Los Cabos where strong infrastructure and vibrant communities welcome visitors year-round.



CABO SAN LUCAS

Lively and exuberant, there's never a shortage of things to do in Cabo San Lucas. While the legendary nightlife is a draw for some crowds, San Lucas is also a hub for artisan shopping, farm-to-table dining and world-class golfing.



SAN JOSÉ DEL CABO

Relaxed and welcoming, this creative community is the gateway to some of the world’s best scuba diving experiences and offers engaging activities such as art walks, farm to table experiences as well as a diving estuary that harbors colorful tropical fish. The charming town is best enjoyed on foot and is only a 20-minute drive from Los Cabos International Airport.



EAST CAPE

A main draw for visitors of Los Cabos along the Baja California Sur state is the hallowed stretch of the East Cape. Secluded and silent, most of the beaches are uncrowded as they require accessing dirt roads in the backcountry –but fear not as there are plenty of easily reachable spots near the hotels. Deep-sea fishing is one of the most sought-after activities, as a wide variety of pelagic species are caught right from the shoreline and out ten kilometers from the coast, including grouper, marlin, sailfish, dorado and tuna.



TOURIST CORRIDOR

The 35-kilometer Tourist Corridor connects San José del Cabo and Cabo San Lucas and boasts beautiful beaches paired with desert views. Accommodations range from deluxe to boutique and include business, family-friendly, adults-only and all-inclusive.



SANTIAGO TOWN

Thirty minutes north of Los Cabos airport, there is a town called Santiago, situated in the Biosphere Sierra La Laguna - a natural reserve park, an oasis in the middle of the desert. Experience the back roads of Baja on your way to the foot of this fantastic mountain range.

PACIFIC OCEAN

An impressive stretch of Pacific coastline and a beautiful highway connecting Cabo San Lucas to Todos Santos is located one hour drive from Cabo San Lucas. Known as The Pacific, it is a place of beautiful beaches and stunning hotels where watching whales swim and turtles migrate are only a part of the experience. The area attracts international artists, avid surfers, and adventurous people.



TODOS SANTOS TOWN

A natural paradise where desert meets the Sierra Laguna Mountain range that is located on the Pacific coast about 45 miles north of Cabo San Lucas. Its culture, its history and its great tourism potential, led to this picturesque village in the municipality of La Paz, to become the first ever magic town of Baja California Sur, category awarded by the Ministry of Tourism, in 2006.



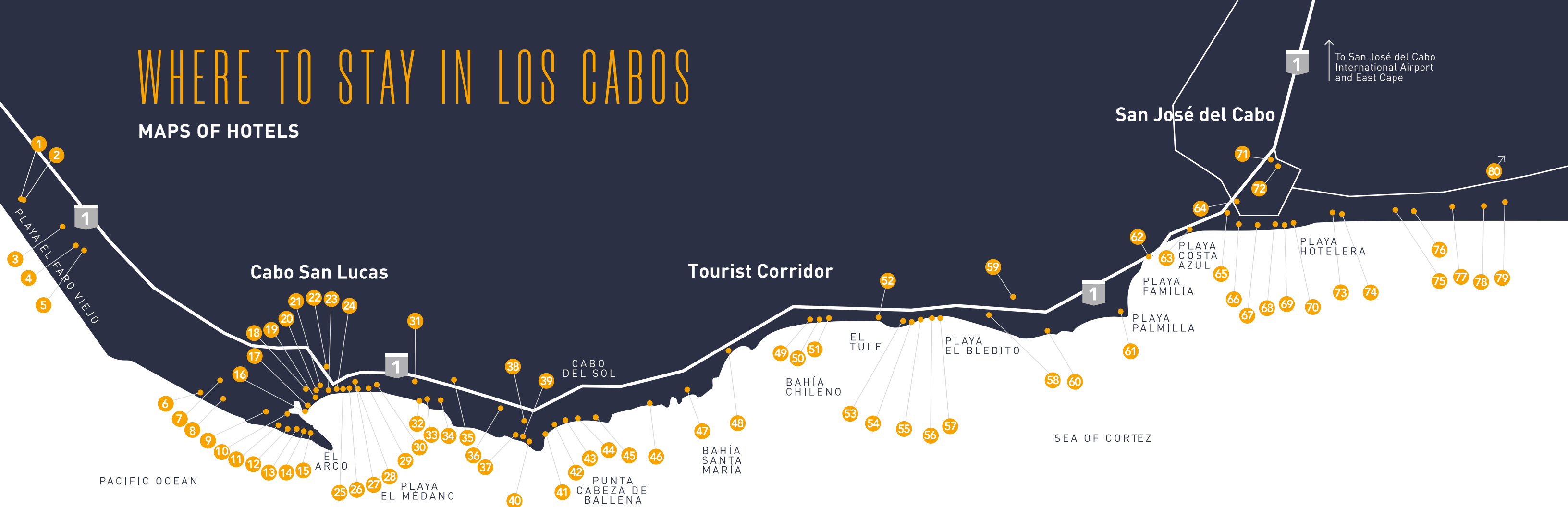
TRAVELING TO LOS CABOS

Los Cabos is on the southern tip of the Baja California Peninsula, west of mainland Mexico and just below the United States. The Sea of Cortés borders Los Cabos to the east and The Pacific Ocean to the west. Los Cabos International Airport (SJD), recognized as one the best 25 airports in the world, is located just 13 kilometers north from San Jose del Cabo and 38 kilometers from Cabo San Lucas.

Los Cabos outstanding connectivity allows the European traveller to comfortably reach its beaches using the more than 500 flights per week from the main cities in Mexico, the United States and Canada. With many upcoming new routes, connectivity is the destination’s number one priority alongside sustainability.

Cabo Pulmo

Approximately two hours away from San Jose del Cabo, lies a scuba-diving epicenter of the world estimated to be more than 20,000 years old: Cabo Pulmo, a treasure of Mexico’s Baja California Peninsula.

Mesmerized by the variety of diverse ecosystems he encountered, Jacques Cousteau himself called the Sea of Cortés “The World’s Aquarium” referring to Cabo Pulmo Marine Preserve, home to hundreds of different vibrant tropical fish species including Sergeant Majors, pufferfish and angelic butterflyfish as well as sea creatures such as gigantic manta rays, sword-nosed marlin, toothy sharks, groupers and even sea turtles.

Recognized as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO, Cabo Pulmo’s unique hard coral reef is one of the most impressive achievements in ocean conservation in history.

A perfect example of eco-tourism at its finest, the region is ideal for those seeking for the quieter, more natural side of Los Cabos. Scuba diving and snorkeling are evidently very popular in this area, providing an up-close look at this amazing underwater ecosystem.



Cabo Pulmo

Five of the world’s seven endangered species of sea turtles find refuge in Cabo Pulmo alongside bull sharks, tiger sharks, hammerhead sharks, blacktip and white tip sharks.

Visitors are encouraged to make an effort to care for the surroundings while experiencing and exploring Cabo Pulmo in various eco-friendly ways.

OFF-THE-GRID ACCOMMODATIONS:

Limiting energy consumption in the area, many accommodations in the village are 100 percent solar-powered. No phone lines and limited electricity keep the area extremely low impact for nature and thus visitors are able to enjoy a nightly sky filled with stars.

SNORKELING EXCURSIONS:

Cabo Pulmo is known for some of the best snorkeling in the world. The Sea of Cortés is one of the most tranquil areas for visitors to explore and certified divers from Eco Adventures escort visitors to explore this living coral reef and experience an incredible underwater world.

LOS CABOS GOLF COURSES

Los Cabos can rightfully claim the title as the ‘Golf Capital of Latin America’, with seven out of the top ten courses in Mexico according to Golf Digest. Home of 18 signature designed courses around high equity real estate developments such as Jack Nicklaus, Greg Norman, Robert Trent Jones Jr, Tiger Woods, David Love III, Tom Fazio and Fred Couples.

PUERTO LOS CABOS GOLF COURSE

Situated on the East Cape a short drive from the colonial city of San Jose del Cabo, the resort community of Puerto Los Cabos offers a 27- hole facility, designed by Jack Nicklaus and Greg Norman.

DIAMANTE CABO SAN LUCAS – THE DUNES COURSE

Powerfully green and sober, the par-72, 7,300- yard Dunes Course was designed by 21-time PGA Tour winner Davis Love III. This beachfront course boasts 18 holes with emerald-green fairways and dramatic views of the Pacific Ocean. Critically acclaimed, it was a Top New International Golf Course in 2010. Its 14-acre practice and performance center is unlike anything else.

DIAMANTE CABO SAN LUCAS – EL CARDONAL

Tiger Woods’ architectural debut, the 18-hole championship El Cardonal, visually complements Diamante’s famed Dunes Course. With dramatic views of the Pacific Ocean and natural arroyos, mature vegetation and native dunes, the par-72 course measures 7,363 yards. It features a long front nine that meanders through rippling dunes, while its back nine gradually ascends.

Facility Type: Private / Resort

Rancho San Lucas

RANCHO SAN LUCAS GOLF CLUB

Designed by legendary golfer and course designer Greg Norman, this course is one of the highlights of the new Grand Solmar at Rancho San Lucas, which sits on two kilometers of beachfront property right on the Pacific. The 7,210-yard layout has a few holes on the beach, notably the par-3 third, which parallels the sea.

Facility Type: Public welcome subject to availability

TWIN DOLPHIN CLUB

This Fred Couples’ signature course features a par-72 layout that stretches to 7,156 yards from the back tees. Built on a broad sloping plateau bisected by three major creeks, it is perched nearly 600 feet above sea level.

Facility Type: Private / Resort

BAY GOLF & BEACH CLUB

Designed by Tom Fazio, the 18-hole, par 72 Chileno Bay Club course provides 7,260 yards of play from the tips. The tees, fairways and greens blend in seamlessly with the surrounding desert terrain, and every hole provides magnificent views of the Sea of Cortés. Right in the heart of the course is the lake that gives name to the bay, a desalinated one with a stunning blue hue. This exquisite course is part of Chileno Bay, a 1,200- acre master-planned resort located on a beautiful beach.

COSTA PALMAS GOLF COURSE

A world-class 18-hole championship golf course, the par 72 course measures 7221 yards of desert and ocean views, perfectly manicured dunes, capes, and fairways that unravel down hillsides. An emerald symphony composed of three movements and three transitions, accentuated by shades of blue. A masterpiece designed by Robert Trent Jones II that sets the golf experience in Baja a world apart. This is The Costa Palmas Golf Club, a destination that is both inspired by and enhances the East Cape’s natural beauty.

Facility Type: The golf facility is offered as an exclusive amenity to Costa Palmas community owners as well as resort guests of the on-site Four Seasons Resort Los Cabos at Costa Palmas.

QUIVIRA GOLF CLUB

This stunning Jack Nicklaus–designed par-72, 18-hole course stretches to 7,085 yards and is set along massive sand dunes, rugged cliffs and white-sand beaches. With views of the Pacific Ocean from all 18 holes, Quivira offers more oceanfront exposure than any other course in Los Cabos. This is Jack Nicklaus’ sixth course design in Los Cabos.

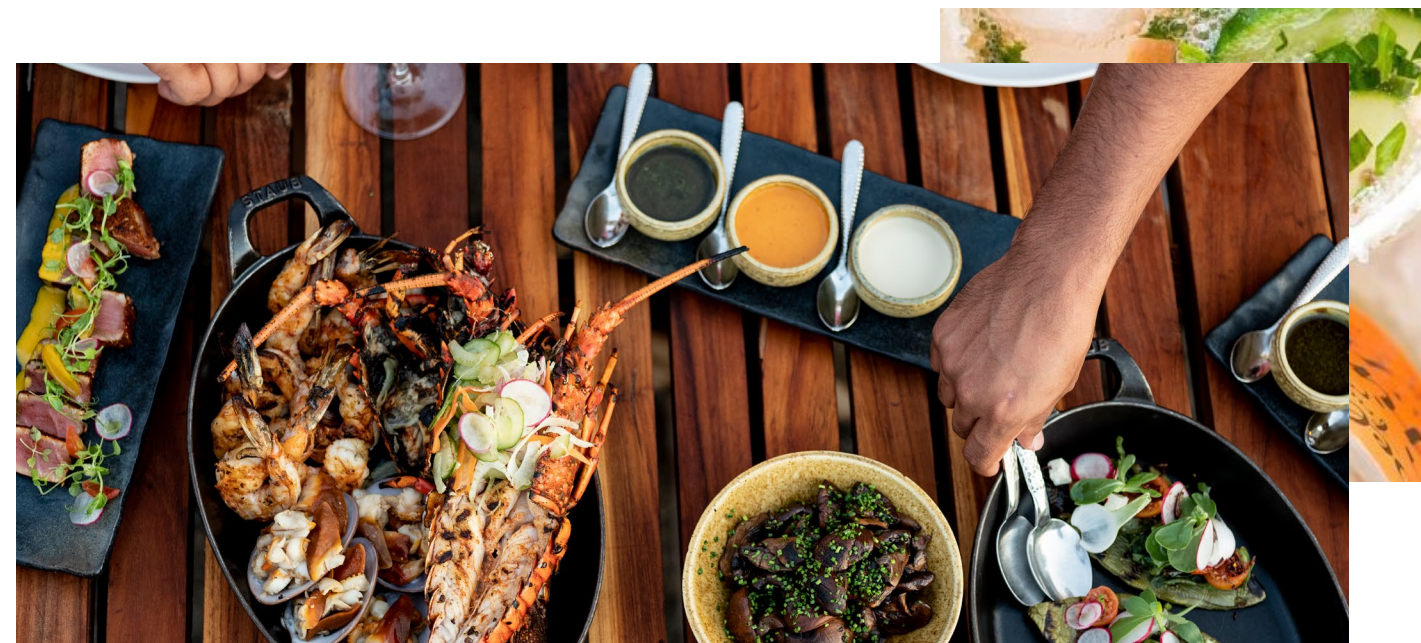

Los Tamarindos is located in a farmhouse dating back to the 19th Century, and due to its fertile soil quickly became one of the region's most important organic farms and restaurants.

ARTS AND CULTURE

Beaches and ocean views, exceptional scuba diving, golf, partying and nightlife, delicious cuisine and stunning upscale resorts may draw millions of leisure seekers to Los Cabos each year, yet a growing calendar of international arts events, local creators, gallerists and arts-centric hotels are fast making this stretch of Mexico's Baja California peninsula a culture culture's stop on the map.

In fact, those who rattle off Mexico City, Merida, San Miguel de Allende, and Oaxaca as Mexico's musts for arts, crafts and culture should immediately add Los Cabos to their list. Lovers of contemporary dance and film surely got a whiff of this shift almost a decade back, thanks to Los Cabos' world-class festivals.

Over in San José del Cabo you'll want to visit the charming and surprisingly sophisticated Gallery District and take part in the weekly **Art Walk**, which takes place on Thursday evenings between November and June. The district is also home to winter's San José del Cabo Jazz Weekend Concert Series.

Here you'll find spaces dedicated to work by some of the most important and trailblazing local artists, including sculptor Julian Garcia Forcelledo's 23-year-old Arte Gallery and studio, and 15-year-old contemporary Galería Corsica. Keep an eye out for pieces by Javier Guadarrama, Victor Mora, Eduardo Mejorada and Spanish-born painter Enrique Bascon, who heads up his own gallery as well.

Gallerist Patricia Mendoza - whose namesake gallery spotlights a diverse range of contemporary creators and work, including conceptual, avant-garde, and cheeky paintings and sculpture, started offering an Art-to-Table experience that sees collaboration between Mexican artists and the area’s organic farms. For this experience, chefs craft menus inspired by the artists and incorporate produce and meat from the local growers. These can be booked for groups directly with the gallery. You can also savor an Art-to-Table experience in Cabo San Lucas with Art Gallery Yandi Monardo. Originally hailing from Uruguay, the multidisciplinary Monardo set up his impressive creative shop here more than 20 years ago.

Viva la Plaza is a combination of culture, music and gastronomy taking place each Friday from 6:00 pm to 10:00 pm in Cabo San Lucas. Surrounded by a high concentration of restaurants with a wide variety of styles, Mexican, Italian, Mediterranean, Asian and coffee shops. Support the local economy and let them show you their Mexican hospitality. It is the Cabo San Lucas family and Culture face, with musical and dance performances, by its typicla Mexican Kiosk at Amelia Wilkes square. Surrounded by hills, jewelry stores, art galleries and more.



Los Cabos International Film Festival

Celebrating its tenth anniversary in 2021, the **Los Cabos International Film Festival** has drawn attendance of over 17,000 at previous editions, including hundreds of film industry professionals. Directors Spike Lee, Terry Gilliam, Oliver Stone and Paul Schrader, and actors Nicole Kidman, Adam Driver, Monica Bellucci, Jared Leto, Jacob Tremblay and Octavia Spencer number among the talents who have presented work, received awards and taken part in events.

The three-day Gala de Danza transforms the Viceroy Los Cabos resort into stages for eye-popping performances that amalgamate dance, music, fashion and cutting-edge multimedia/technology, dramatically juxtaposed against the Sea of Cortés. Some guest rooms serve as VIP suites, with clear views from the balconies and even bathtubs, which led Dance Magazine to call Gala de Danza possibly “the most lavish dance show on earth.”

Another festival to keep an eye out for is the six-year-old **Esperanzarte**. Taking place at the Esperanza private beach resort, this event represents an immersive combination of cocktail party, art exhibition and live music performance during which Los Cabos’ chefs create unique tasting menus with wine pairings to complement Mexican artists’ works. Esperanza also hosts its weekly “Paint and Sip” event every Friday night. SIGHTSEEING / HEAD TO THE DESERT

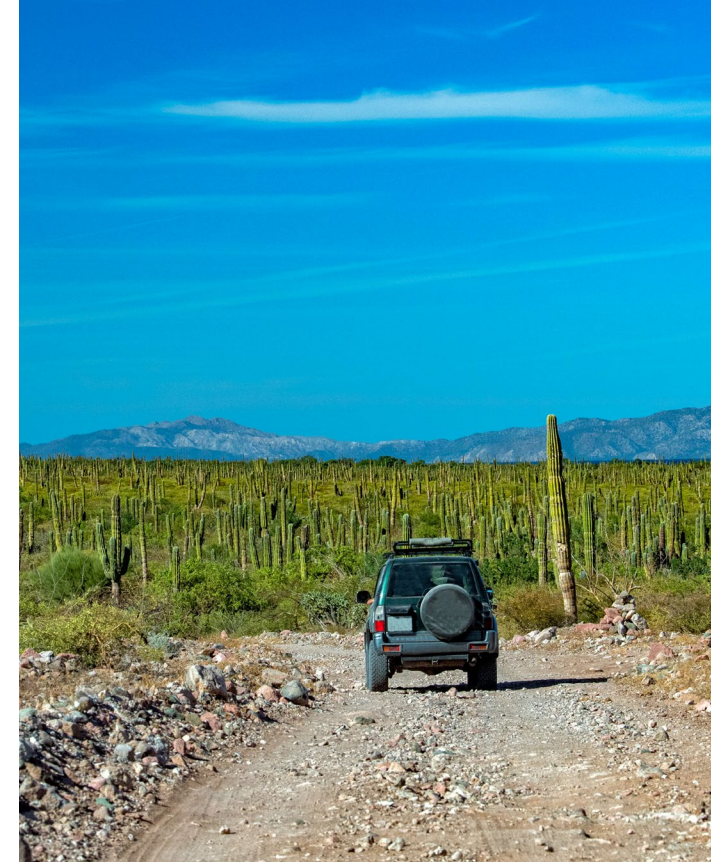
Visit a real desert oasis not far from the ocean and the sea.

If you want to immerse yourself in an adventure in a less frequented part of Baja California Sur, consider a day trip into the outback, an arid country with sweeping vistas. Just 55 kilometers north of Land’s End, the quaint rural town of Santiago is home to flourishing orchards and working ranches that make the land resemble a verdant island amid a sea of desert scrub. Santiago doubles as the gateway to the Cabo Real Ecological Reserve, which itself skirts the Sierra de la Laguna Mountain range. Designated a UNESCO global biosphere reserve in 1994, the range is graced with a wealth of biodiverse vegetation and magnificent rock formations. Located within the reserve, the locally owned Rancho Ecologico Sol de Mayo is home to some of the region’s most iconic flora and fauna, including lizards, quails, roadrunners, rabbits, and the occasional ring-tailed cat. Hit the trail early to get a better chance of seeing the animals.



The drive to the ranch is easy, though it is recommended that you rent an all-wheel drive vehicle to get there, as the last several miles are unpaved and uneven. The varied fleet at Ten Car Rental includes midsize sports utility vehicles and Jeeps, ideally suited for this kind of adventure. Once at the ranch, be prepared to pay a nominal fee to the park and another small fee to access the trail that leads to the waterfall. The hike down to the waterfall itself can take as little as 10 minutes, but the return trip takes longer, as it is up the steep incline. You can assist yourself on the rustic but functional trail with railings and ropes you’ll find along the way. The ranch offers a few amenities, including restrooms, fresh meals and beverages, and even cabins for overnight stays. When the picturesque, 12-meter cascading fall comes into view, it’s easy to feel like you have traveled a world away. This natural formation invites visitors to step back in time, as huge granite rocks atop the Sol de Mayo waterfall funnel its crystalline, spring-feed water into a pool below — a sight that has attracted locals to the area for centuries. In fact, you may run into a few locals enjoying the peaceful spot while you’re there.

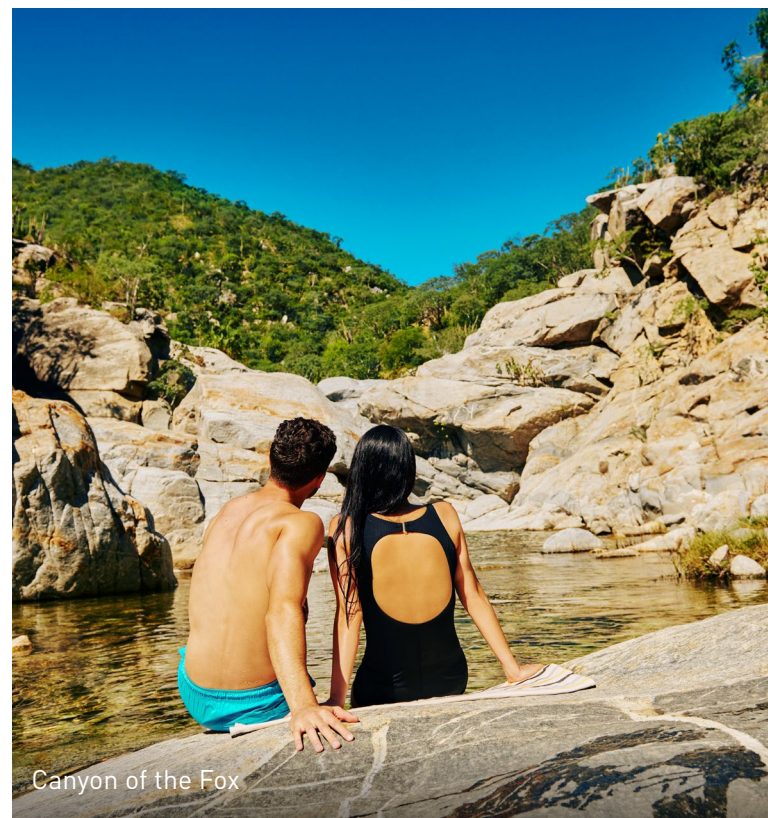


Visitors can easily spend the whole day cooling off in the natural swimming hole absorbing the laid-back atmosphere. The deep pool provides the perfect pick-me-up for adults after a day of exploring, while a safe sandy shallow area is best for kids and less confident swimmers. The water is cool and refreshing, but at the height of summer may be reduced to a trickle or dry up completely. Various destination management companies, such as Terramara and Mexico Planners organize hiking tours, and can personalize your experience. Their knowledgeable guides provide information about the land, its vegetation and the spots where you are most likely to see specific animals alongside the indigenous people who lived in the area hundreds of years ago.

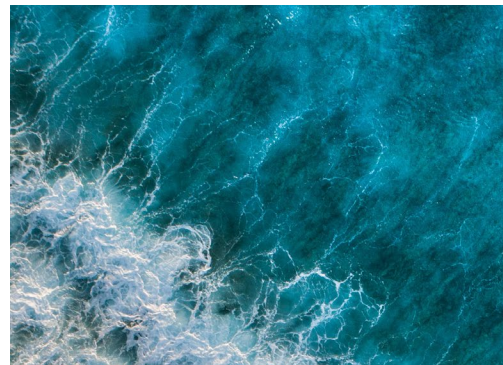
The most important item to remember when heading out on a hiking trip through desert trails is a good pair of comfortable, closed-toe walking shoes - indispensable for managing the uneven and steep terrain. So swap the flip-flops for a pair of good hiking boots. Other items to pack include a swimsuit, sunscreen, sunglasses, a hat, plenty of water, a small rucksack to carry everything and, of course, a camera or phone to capture your memories. You may also want to pick up some food and drinks at the ranch prior to trekking down the trail to enjoy a scenic picnic when you’ve made it.

BIG GAME FISHING

The waters of Los Cabos comprise the Pacific Ocean and the Sea of Cortés. Both are rich in prolific marine environments and submarine sea mounts, where a myriad species can be found anywhere from right along the shoreline out to 100 kilometers. Big game fishing in Los Cabos is highlighted by its world-renowned striped marlin fishery, but other seafaring sportfish include blue marlin, black marlin, wahoo, yellowfin tuna and dorado.

The easiest way to have an unparalleled Los Cabos fishing experience is to charter a boat. Picante Sportfishing runs daily trips out to the fishing grounds right around Land's End: the eight to eighty kilometers range where you can target marlin species. Luxury charter vessels from the Pisces Fleet are built with world-class service in mind. Charter boats are equipped with the latest size of 50 to 80 class gold conventional reels matched with stand-up heavy duty rods spooled with 35 kilo lines, suitable for a strenuous battle with a billfish. When making the one to three hour run offshore, nothing beats traveling in comfort and style, and these sportfishing yachts are decked out with comfortable couches, fully stocked refrigerators and even TVs to keep your party entertained. Once at the grounds, captains and mates work hard setting a

trolling spread of lures and baits to tempt marlin, tuna, wahoo and dorado. A spread can contain up to 10 rods out as the lures crashing across the water surface resemble a school of baitfish, triggering a reaction strike from the pelagic species. Trolling is a fairly easy way to get strikes, as once the spread is set, rods are placed in the rod holders in the gunwales, and the boat simply cruises at a six- to eight-knot pace dragging the lures in its wake. You'll certainly know when you get a hit. The reel's drag system starts singing and screaming as the fish rips line off at a breakneck pace. While dorado and wahoo are generally reeled in within 15 to 20 minutes, marlin pushing 220 to 370 kilograms and tuna weighing in at over 100 kilos can sometimes test the willpower, spirit and stamina.

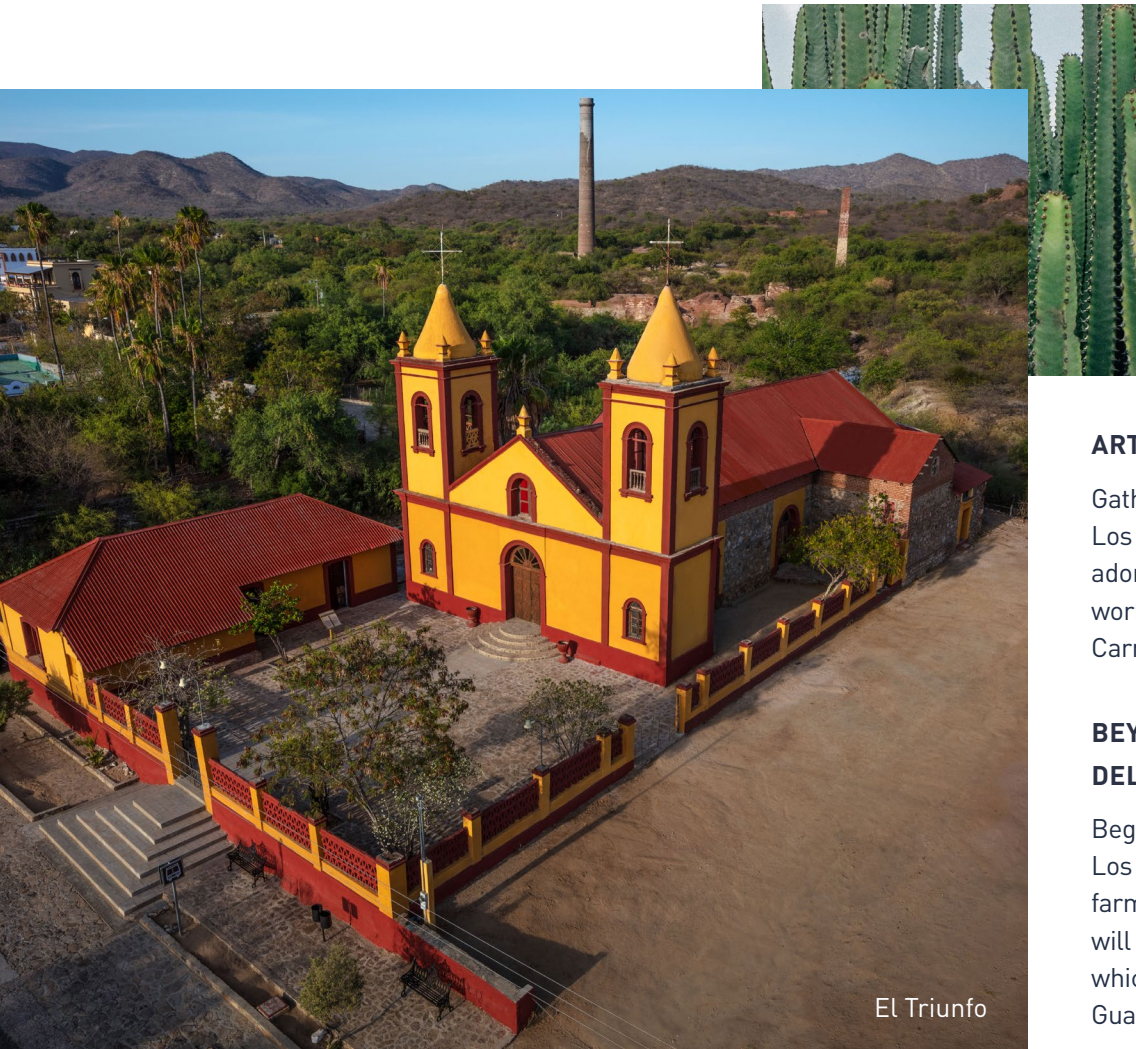
