Unique Venues

More than 60 unique meeting and event venues include wineries, breweries, storied estates, historic-to-modern farmhouses and beyond.

Stone Tower Winery offers indoor and outdoor spaces with sweeping views of vineyards and rolling hills. Historic Morven Park features a stately mansion and lush grounds, while The Barn at Brambleton elevates farmhouse charm with its striking modern design features.

Intimate Outdoor Venues

Standout settings include Old Farm Winery at Hartland, featuring a historic farmhouse, new pavilion and idyllic lawn on 18th-century farmland. Lost Barrel Brewing's scenic yard has cozy fire pits and Honor Brewery offers an inviting patio and lawn alongside its modern building.
