

Accessible Lodging on Mackinac Island

Bay View B&B

Accessible Rooms: 1 room

Elevator: No

Shower: Small lip with grab bar

Bathroom: Higher toilet and grab bar

Beds: 1 room with a single Queen bed

Details: This is a good option for someone with limited mobility. There is room on the porch to leave an electric mobility scooter or wheelchair. Located on the first level, no steps to get to the dining room.

Bicycle Street Inn

Accessible Rooms: All doorways are 36"

Elevator: Yes

Shower: 2 rooms have roll-in shower

Bathroom: ADA compliant bars in 5 bathrooms

Beds: 2 rooms with double Queen beds and 3 rooms with single King bed

Details: All floors served by elevator that will accommodate wheelchair or scooter and aid someone with limited mobility.

Accessibility Information:

Chippewa Hotel

Accessible Rooms: 3 rooms

Elevator: Yes

Shower: Roll-in shower

Bathroom: Support bars in bathroom

Beds: 1 room with double Queen beds and 2 rooms with single King bed

Details: First Room: 1 King bed on the water side of the hotel. It also has a living room and a balcony. The bed is lower, which makes it easier to get in and out and into a mobility device.

Second Room: 2 Queen beds on the water side of the hotel. It has a full separate living room and a balcony overlooking the lake. The beds are lower, which makes it easier to get in and out of the bed and into a mobility device.

Third Room: 1 King bed on the Main Street side of the hotel with a window view. Great option for an economically priced accessible room on the island.

Cottage Inn

Accessible Rooms: 1 room

Elevator: No

Shower: Roll in shower with drop down seat and support bars

Bathroom: Support bars in the bathroom

Beds: 1 deluxe Queen bed

Details: The accessible room is located on the first floor where breakfast is also served. Bigger bathroom to accommodate a wheelchair or scooter. Very accommodating staff, call for more info.

Grand Hotel

Accessible Rooms: 11 rooms

Elevator: Yes

Shower: Some rooms have a roll in shower. Others have a bath tub.

Bathroom: Support bars in bathrooms

Beds: Variety of room options including double Queen beds, 2 Double beds, single Queen beds, and single King beds

Details: There are three elevators within Grand Hotel. The middle elevator just off the lobby goes to every floor and is the most accessible. The front door next to the check in desk is wheelchair accessible. The pool has a shallow no-step entry and wheelchair ramps. Please call the reservations department for more information regarding accessibility and room details.

Harbour View Inn

Accessible Rooms: 4 rooms

Elevator: Yes

Shower: Roll in showers

Bathroom: Support bars in bathroom

Beds: 1 room with a single Queen bed and 3 rooms with single King beds + sofa sleeper

Details: Harbour View Inn is located on a hill. Taxis will drop off at the lobby but guest rooms are located away from the main building. Call them directly for more details.

Inn on Mackinac

Accessible Rooms: 0 rooms

Elevator: Yes

Shower: There is not a roll in shower

Bathroom: No support bars in bathroom

Beds: All rooms feature single or double Queen beds

Details: The Inn on Mackinac does not have ADA accessible rooms, however, their elevator is a great option for people with limited mobility.

Island House Hotel

Accessible Rooms: 2 rooms

Elevator: Yes

Shower: There is not a roll in shower

Bathroom: Support bars in bathroom

Beds: 2 rooms both have a single King bed

Details: To enter the hotel, there is a lift available, or about 7 steps to reach the lobby level. To enter the dining room, there is a lift available, or about 4 steps. There is an elevator that accesses the second and third floor (first floor rooms require about 7 steps)

Lake View Hotel

Accessible Rooms: 4 rooms

Elevator: Yes

Shower: No roll in showers in ADA accessible rooms, however, there are roll in shower options in non-ADA rooms

Bathroom: Support bars in bathroom

Beds: 4 rooms with single King beds + roll away bed option

Details: Accessible ramp located on French Lane(west) side of the hotel

Lilac Tree Suites

Accessible Rooms: 2 rooms

Elevator: Yes

Shower: Roll in showers

Bathroom: Support bars in bathroom

Beds: Each room has a single King Bed

Details: First Room: 1 King bed on the island side of the hotel (window view). It also has a living room with a mini fridge, microwave, and coffee maker. The bed is lower, which makes it easier to get in and out and into a mobility device.

Second Room: 1 King bed on the island side of the hotel (window view). It also has a living room with a mini fridge, microwave, and coffee maker. The bed is lower, which makes it easier to get in and out and into a mobility device.

Most of the rooms at the Lilac Tree are able to accommodate a wheelchair and are all large and comfortable.

Mackinac House

Accessible Rooms: 1 room

Elevator: No

Shower: Barrier free roll in shower with seat and bars

Bathroom: Support bars by toilet

Beds: 1 room with a single King bed

Details: Mackinac House has a ramp entrance and the accessible room is located on the first floor. Everything is accessible if guests stay in this room. Guests can charge their electric mobility scooters in the lobby area.

Main Street Inn

Accessible Rooms: 1 room

Elevator: Yes

Shower: Step in shower, about 2 inch lip.

Bathroom: Support bars in bathroom

Beds: 1 room with a single King bed

Details: No stairs necessary. Use the ramp from the road to the side walk

Market Street Inn

Accessible Rooms: 2 rooms

Elevator: No

Shower: 1 room has a regular tub/shower with support bars. 1 room has a step in shower with a small lip.

Bathroom: Support bars in 1 of the 2 bedrooms

Beds: 1 room with a single Queen bed and 1 room with a single King bed

Details: 1st floor is wheelchair accessible

Mission Point Resort

Accessible Rooms: 1 room

Elevator: Yes

Shower: Standard bath tub/shower with grab bars

Bathroom: No support bars in bathroom

Beds: 1 room with 2 double beds

Details: When booking, it is best to call Mission Point directly vs. booking online. A reservations agent can walk you through what the best options are and gather information to help them provide a great experience.

Murray Hotel

Accessible Rooms: 2 rooms

Elevator: Yes

Shower: No roll in showers

Bathroom: Support bars in the bathroom

Beds: 1 room with a single Queen bed and 1 room with two Queen beds

Details: Ramp at the front doors of the hotel
