HOW TO GET TO MACKINAC ISLAND



BY CAR

- From the south, take I-75 to the ferry docks in either Mackinaw City or St. Ignace.
- From the north, take I-75 or U.S. 2 to the ferry docks in either St. Ignace or Mackinaw City.
- Here's ***what to do with your car when visiting Mackinac Island.***



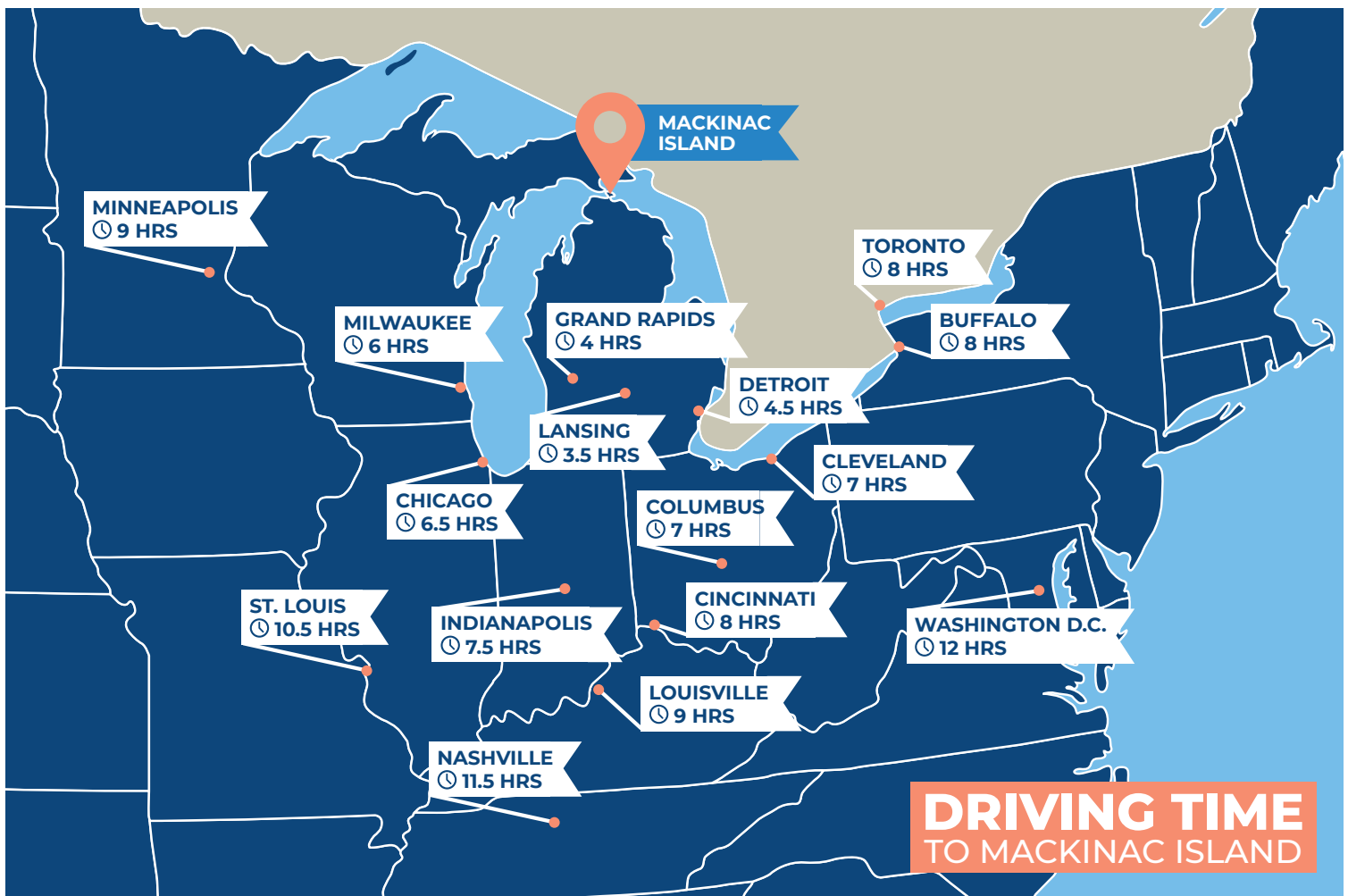
BY FERRY

- Both ***Shepler's Mackinac Island Ferry*** and ***Arnold Transit Company*** offer boats to Mackinac Island and back from late April through the end of October. The ferry ride takes about 20 minutes from either Mackinaw City or St. Ignace.
- You can ***take a private boat to Mackinac Island*** and dock it in the public marina or one of the many private boat slips in Mackinac Island State Harbor.



BY PLANE

- Take a commercial flight*** into Pellston Regional Airport (PLN) or Chippewa County International Airport (CIU), where you can catch a shuttle (Mackinaw Shuttle or Northern Transport) to the Mackinac Island ferry docks.
- Arrange a ***charter flight*** directly to Mackinac Island. They can pick you up from airports all over the US or close by like Traverse City (TVC), Pellston (PLN) or Chippewa County (CIU), call ***Fresh Air Aviation***, ***North Country Aviation*** or ***Northwoods Aviation***.
- Take an air taxi into Mackinac Island Airport with ***Fresh Air Aviation*** or ***Northwoods Aviation***. The flight from St. Ignace takes about 7 minutes.



THINGS TO KNOW FOR OUR MOTOR COACH PARTNERS



Shepler's Ferry and Arnold Transit Company have bus parking available. Contact them for more details about parking on the mainland.



Luggage is unloaded on the mainland ferry docks onto carts and transported to Mackinac Island. The staff at Shepler's Mackinac Island Ferry and Arnold Transit Company will be able to assist with luggage.



Once on the Island, luggage is transported to your hotel by a dockporter or pulled on the cart by a horse and carriage. Please arrange these details with the hotel.



To get around Mackinac Island guests will need to walk, bike, or call a horse-drawn taxi. Electric mobility scooters and wheelchairs can be brought over on the ferry or rented on the Island.



Downtown Mackinac Island is about 3 blocks long.



Mackinac Island is mostly flat around the perimeter of the Island (8.2 miles) and in the downtown area. Anytime you go into the interior, you must **ascend the hill or bluff.**

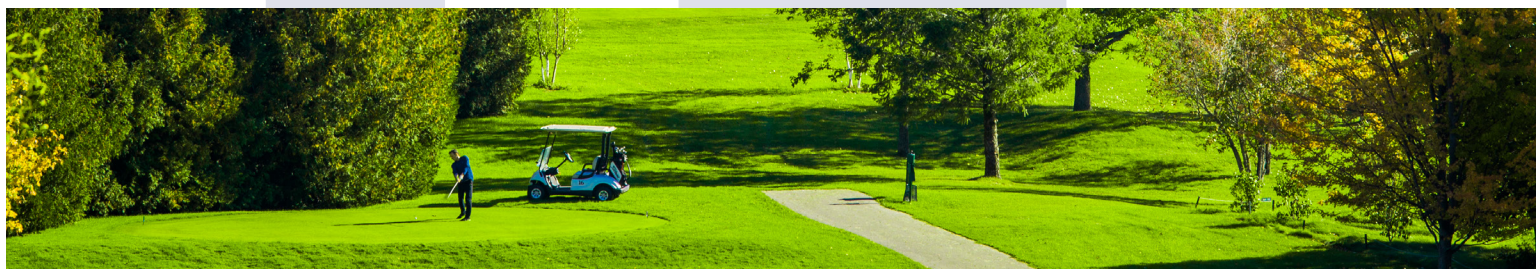
