MONONA TERRACE® COMMUNITY AND CONVENTION CENTER

The Frank Lloyd Wright-designed Monona Terrace is a stunning, multi-level facility located in the heart of downtown Madison on the shores of Lake Monona. It was one of the first U.S. convention centers to be LEED-certified and recently earned the esteemed LEED Gold Certification for its sustainability efforts. This facility offers:

- 40,000 square-foot exhibition hall
- 14,000 square-foot ballroom
- 310 seat multimedia lecture hall
- 20 additional meeting rooms (28,000 square feet total)
- · 600-space attached parking garage
- 68,000 square-foot rooftop garden that can be used as an event space





TRANSPORTATION

Though we pride ourselves on being a walkable destination, our airport is located just 10 minutes from downtown and convention centers, so we also offer abundant transportation options:

- Free airport shuttles at most hotels
- Three taxi companies plus Uber
- Madison BCycle, an urban bike-sharing program with 40 stations citywide



ALLIANT ENERGY CENTER CAMPUS

Conveniently located just minutes from downtown Madison, the 164-acre Alliant Energy Center campus features facilities to accommodate an array of meeting and event needs. This venue is Travel Green certified for its efforts to build sustainable tourism through its use of greenspace and other sustainability efforts. This facility offers:

- New Holland Pavilions, two exhibition pavilions with 290,000 total square feet of flexible, functional space
- An **Exhibition Hall** that offers a 155,000 square-foot exhibition hall with space for 650 booths, plus 14 meeting rooms that total 20,000 square feet
- Veterans Memorial Coliseum venue, with 10,231-person capacity and 20,000-75,000 square feet of flexible, functional space
- 5,800 on-site, paved parking spaces
- Willow Island, 29 acres of natural green space on a six-acre isthmus encircled by two ponds with electrical power onsite and flexible space
