FOOD & CRAFT BEVERAGES

THE INTERNATIONAL BOXING HALL OF FAME AND MUSEUM

Located in Canastota, this sport's showcase highlights the lives and careers of boxing's best.

THE GREAT SWAMP **CONSERVANCY**

Canastota's beauty is on display in this Audubon Society-designated "Important Birding Area," home to more than 180 species of birds.

THE OLD ERIE CANAL

This engineering marvel transformed our nation two centuries ago. Today, the canal's many outdoor adventure opportunities and two museums draw thousands of visitors each year.

ALL THINGS OZ

Chittenango-the birthplace of L. Frank Baum, author of The Wonderful Wizard of Oz-features an Oz-themed casino, annual festival, museum, and yellow brick sidewalks downtown.

DOWNTOWN CAZENOVIA & HAMILTON

With their stunning settings, culture, arts, boutique and specialty shops, and excellent restaurants, the charm of these historic villages will captivate you.

THE UNDERGROUND RAILROAD

This featured location in Peterboro is where Gerrit Smith used his wealth to move escaped slaves to freedom, purchase African Americans from slavery, and finance state and national abolition activities. Tour Smith's estate year-round.

THE ONEIDA COMMUNITY MANSION HOUSE NATIONAL HISTORIC LANDMARK

This beautiful 93,000-square-foot mansion was home to the Oneida Community, adherents of a 19th century utopian ideal.

THE FENNER RENEWABLE **ENERGY EDUCATION (FREE)** CENTER

Located in the heart of the Fenner Wind Farm, the Center shares information about the benefits of using renewable energy technologies, including wind, solar, hydro, biomass, and others.

LORENZO STATE HISTORIC SITE

Majestically overlooking the southern shores of Cazenovia Lake, the Lorenzo mansion offers the opportunity to discover the impact of one trailblazing family and enjoy a variety of exhibitions, open-air concerts, garden events, a one-room school house and more!

DAY 1:

International Boxing Hall of Fame - The Hall of Fame features robes and gloves worn by boxing greats plus the world-famous Madison Square Garden Ring.

Gerrit Smith Estate & National Abolition Hall of Fame and Museum - Tour the Estate and stand where Harriet Tubman,

The Museum at Cazenovia Public Library -Immerse yourself in more than two thousand years of history. Here you can see an ancient Egyptian mummy, early Native American tools and more.
