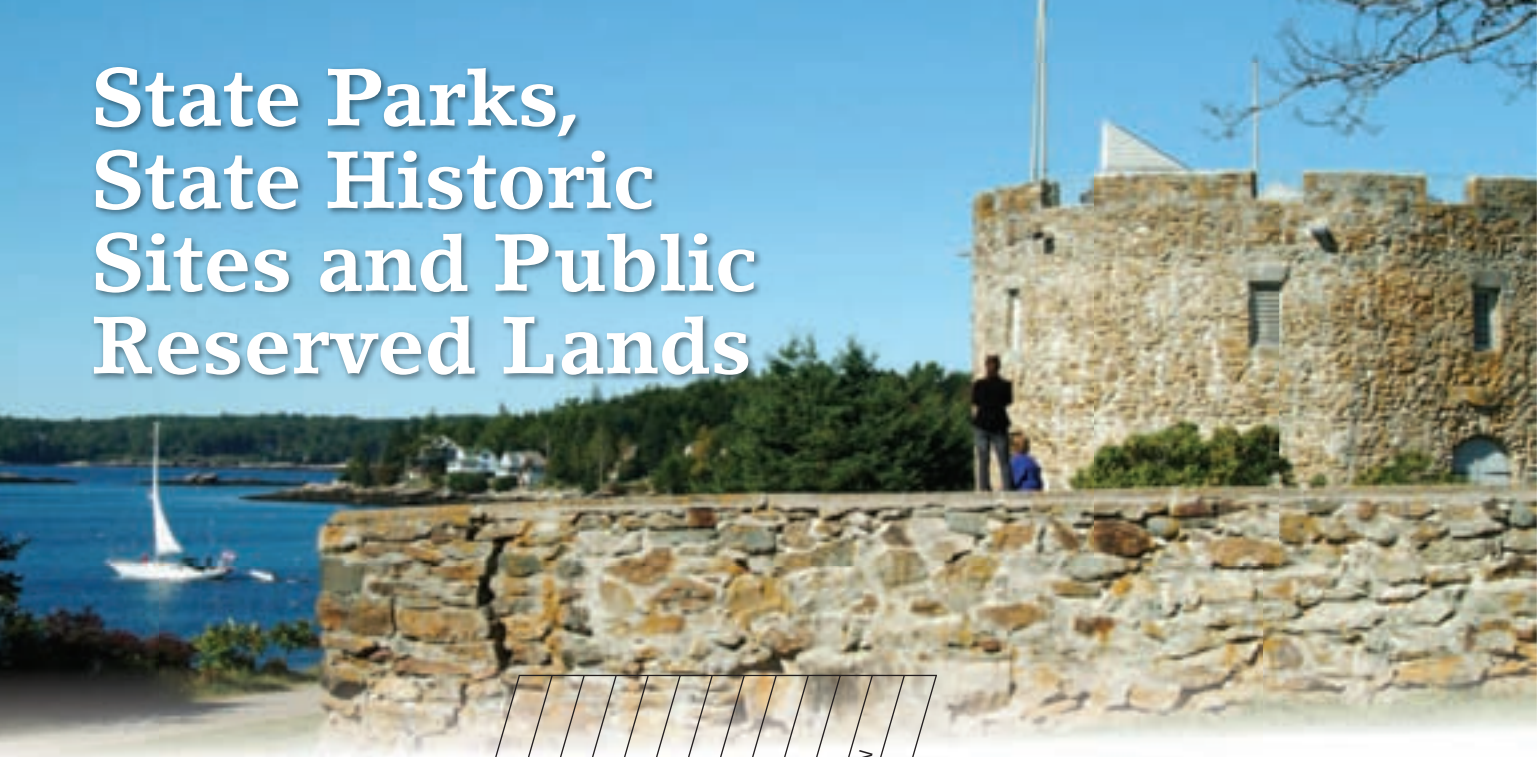

* All trails at state parks and public reserved lands have hiking opportunities. Depending on the time of year, some trails in selected state parks also have shared use opportunities for:

- cross-country skiing
- riding ATVs
- horseback riding
- riding mountain bikes

ATV, equestrian, and bicycle use is allowed on gravel roads on public reserved lands that have the green and white sign indicating "Shared Use Road."

Call individual parks or public reserved land units for information about specific trail uses allowed in each area.

There are generally no formal picnic areas on Public Reserved Lands. Informal picnicking without fires is permitted.
