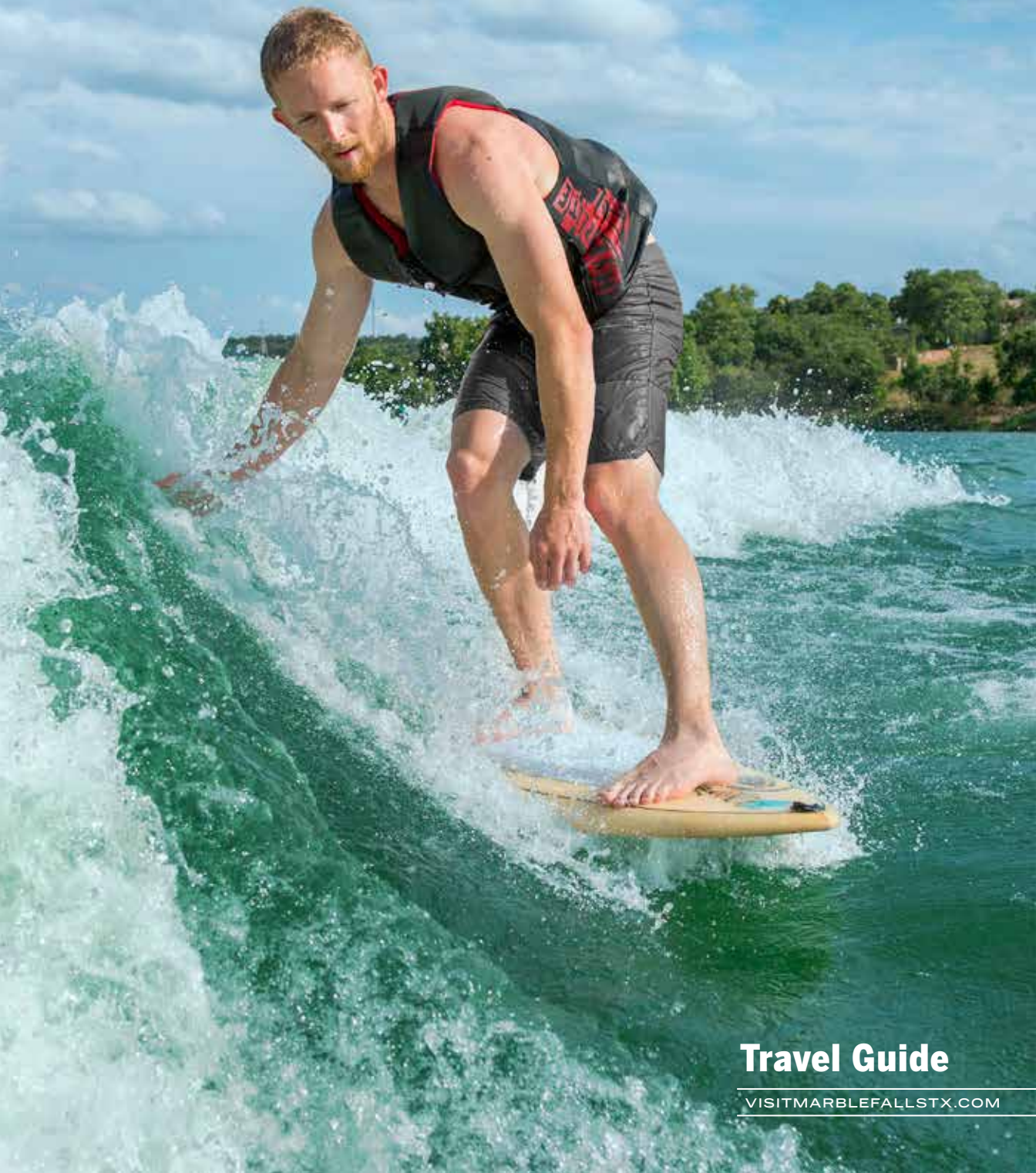

SPRING

Two words: wildflower season. Two more words: and festivals. When you're not marveling at the bluebonnet displays, take in one of Marble Falls' signature outdoor gatherings, like **Main Street Market Day**, **Mayfest**, **Paint the Town**, **Sculpture on Main**, or the **Howdy Roo Food Festival**.

SUMMER

Around here, a lot of summer days are spent near water. **Lakefest** brings the boats, **Slide! Marble Falls** brings the adrenaline, and **Fireworks over Lake Marble Falls** brings the oohs and the ahs. You can also soak in more fun with events like the **Downtown Farmers Market**, **The Marble Falls Rodeo**, and **Market in the Park**.

WINTER

There's no hibernating in these hills. When the weather cools, it's time for celebrations. **The Marble Falls Walkway of Lights** is a can't-miss Hill Country tradition. Pair that fun with other events like the **Community Christmas Tree Lighting**, **Winter Ice Skating Rink**, **Christmas Market on Main**, **Ice Sculpture on Main**, and **Victorian Christmas Home Tour**.



FALL

Fall is the time to, well, fall into whatever suits your fancy. The **Kiwanis Car Show** fills the town with shiny classics for old souls and antiquers alike. Not too far away, the **Marble Falls Music Festival** provides all who are near with the sweet sound of live music. And of course, **Halloween in the Park** brings all the spook and sugar a little one can handle.

The perfect weekend itinerary consists of delicious food, close friends, and unique activities that provide an unforgettable getaway. Marble Falls is the ultimate destination to frolic leisurely through Downtown and soak up the tranquil sun alongside the serene waters of Lake Marble Falls. This Highland Lakes journey is meditative, joyful, adventurous, and refreshing.

DAY 1

- Skip out of town early to arrive in time for lunch at **River City Grille** for a spectacular plate of catfish on the patio. Sit back and relax, the weekend begins here.

- **Just Yakin'** offers stand-up paddleboarding and kayaking, which is quickly becoming a trademark on Lake Marble Falls. The calm water provides the perfect setting for balancing on a board and taking in the cliffs of the Texas Hill Country. Park your board and settle into the Beach at Lakeside Park.

- **The Beach at Lakeside Park** is a favorite among locals and tourists, offering a perfect swimming launch for the whole family. Take in the sights and sounds of lake life with a frame of sand to bring all of the vacation vibes.



- Dust off the sand and head over to **Bear King Brewing Co.** for an unbeatable burger or fish tacos. The local brewery boasts a wide selection of beverages, so sit back and enjoy on the outdoor patio to the tune of some local live music.



DAY 2

- It's nearing the 24-hour mark, so stop by **Ragtime Oriole** for some fresh dark roast coffee. Egg bites and kolaches are also available if you need more fuel than the caffeine variety.

- Cross 281 for a morning yoga class at **Heart & Soul**. The historic house provides an additional layer of meditative properties as all the history slowly unfolds in the woodwork.

- Keep that serene feeling and walk down 3rd street to **Ginger & Spice** for a versatile menu of Asian dishes. The classic fare is sure to satisfy the pickiest eater, so when in doubt order the Pad Thai or Basil Fried Rice. Grab a cookie for dessert from **Sugar Mama Cookies** and stroll on!



- Peruse the local shops as you walk Downtown and take in the art installations of **Sculpture on Main** sponsored by local nonprofit Highland Lakes Creative Arts. Be sure to check out **Smartie Pantz**, which always stocks their shelves with the latest trends and gifts. On your way to **Chocolatte's & Third Street Treasures**, write something from your personal bucket list on the **Before I Die** wall, located along **Oh So Yummy!** Grab an alternate pair of walking shoes from the impeccable selection at **Blue Suede Shoes** to keep the journey going and saunter over to **Eve Couture** and **Monroe's on Main**.



- Bring something home to commemorate your weekend from **Pam's Pearl Home** or **ReDid**, both home furnishing stores. And be sure to loop through **Ms Lollipop Parties, Fun & Gifts**, an impressive display of nostalgia featuring a twist on the classic soda-fountain-meets-old-school-toy-store.

- The best Saturday ends with a wine tasting at **Fiesta Winery**.

- Dinner at **Oli's Kitchen** is the crowd pleaser to write home about. This is not your typical Mexican food restaurant, as the menu offers power bowls and a signature cilantro salad.



DAY 3

- Good morning, Sunday. This is the opportunity to experience breakfast at **Blue Bonnet Café**. Get there early and order the pancakes along with the perfect cup of diner coffee. Trust this recommendation.

- The Highland Lakes is known as an artist refuge and **Indian River** offers an interactive art experience to capture the power of creative art in the community.

- Before hitting the road, be sure to grab one last bite at **Adriano's** in Old Oak Square. The patio is the perfect opportunity to soak up the last bit of the weekend with a plate of marinara or chicken piccata.

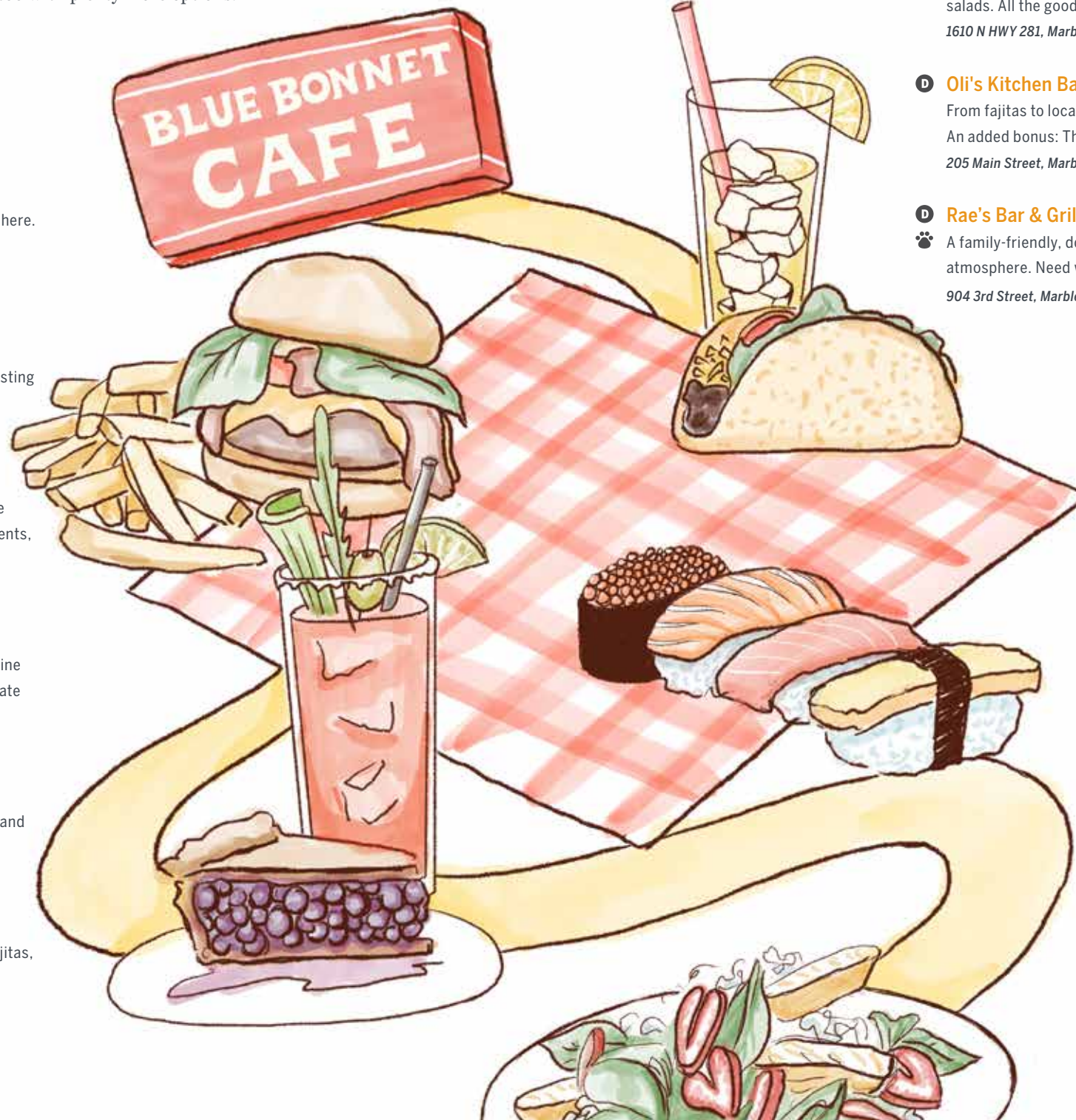

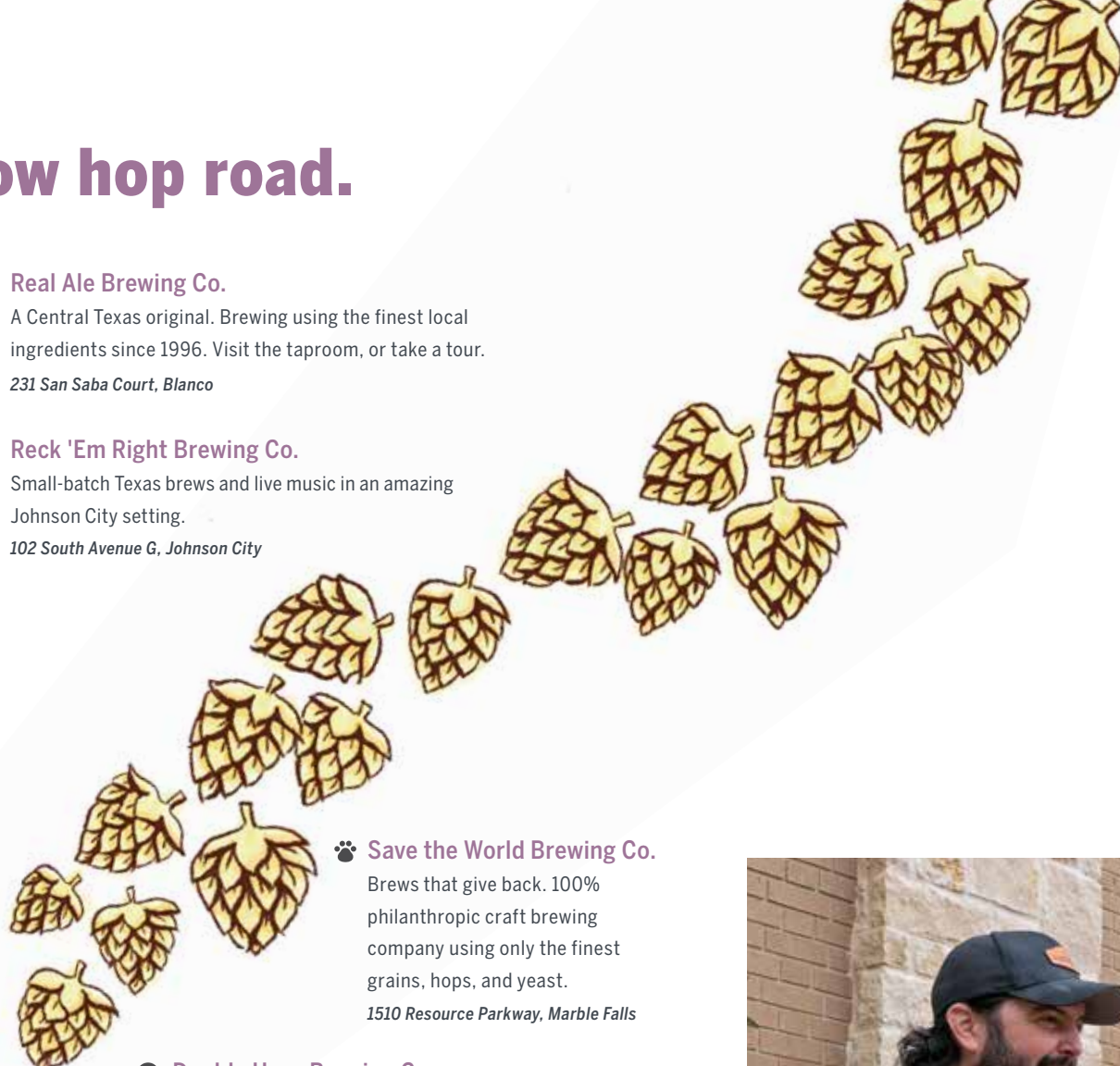

RAISE A GLASS AT DOUBLE HORN BREWING COMPANY

Ten years ago, Dusty Knight turned his beer-making hobby into Double Horn Brewery, becoming the first brewpub in Burnet County. The name originally spurred from his home brewery in the Double Horn neighborhood, then Knight learned about the town of Double Horn that came before him, and the name felt even more fitting.

Now Knight has a whole line of light, malty, and hoppy beers on tap, including the 1855 Pale Ale, inspired by the town of Double Horn's founding year. The food menu holds its own as well, plating American fare

with a twist. (Think smoked Reuben sandwiches and BLTs with pork schnitzel.)

Knight believes it's the people he's surrounded by that make this place so great - although we'd argue he's just as wonderful. Under his wing, the brewery hosts a charity night once a month that donates a portion of the day's proceeds to a local organization. And on top of that, he hopes to be 100% employee-owned by 2023. Cheers to that and that.

Steps for tasting wine

There's so much wine to savor in and around Marble Falls. So to taste like a sommelier, remember the four S method. Salud!

1. See

EVALUATE BY SIGHT

Assess the wine's visual character. Varieties in color, haziness, and thickness are clues to a wine's type and origin.

2. Swirl

AERATE THE FLAVOR

Release the aromatics of the wine's flavor by giving the glass a swirl, allowing air to flow through it. Wine glasses are uniquely crafted to allow space for this step to take place.

3. Smell

IDENTIFY FLORAL AROMAS

Capturing the flavor's scent helps to determine whether a wine is young or old. Newer wines will have pungent aromas, while older wines will have subtle floral undertones.

4. Sip

SAVOR THE TASTE

Tasting the wine should confirm your interpretation of the flavor's bouquet. Take note of whether the wine releases floral, herb, mineral, or barrel flavors. Then neutralize your palate, and it's on to the next tasting.

Ter-roir (noun) : The complete natural environment in which a particular wine is produced, including factors such as the soil, topography, and climate.

The Texas Hill Country is known for its wine scene, and Marble Falls is at the heart of both. Classic varietals, experimental ideas, and wide-open spaces—here's to finding your favorites.

10 QUESTIONS TO ASK AT A WINERY

1. What are the grape varieties used in this wine?

This will tell you the wine's composition, giving you the basic essentials to better understand the general properties and origins of wines.

2. What types of grapes are grown at this vineyard?

There are over 10,000 varieties of grapes in the world, inspiring wineries to create signature blends based on the region they reside in.

3. How long are your wines aged?

The timeline of wine aging varies based on grape varietal, fermentation technique and desired flavor.

4. How does barrel-aging change the flavors of your wines?

Barrel aging gives wine a unique, oak-like flavor. And steel barrel-aging offers a different profile. After enough wine tasting, you may be able to identify a barrel-aged wine from a wine that undergoes a different fermentation process.

5. How are your wines fermented?

Fermentation processes vary by winery, wine type, and region. Differences in fermentation techniques determine sugar-alcohol content—and flavor.

6. How do you know when a wine is at its peak?

Winemakers can identify a wine's peak years, indicating when one should drink it to enjoy the best flavor.

7. What would you pair these wines with?

Most wineries will have recommendations about spices or recipes that pair well with their wines.

8. What is your go-to wine for each season?

Often, wine preference mirrors food preference, meaning seasonal flavor choices will translate to seasonal wine recommendations.

9. Are any of your wines a blend?

"Blended" refers to wine that is composed of more than one grape varietal, sometimes from the same vineyard, sometimes from different regions, to create new flavors.

10. At what temperature should this wine be served to ensure the best flavor?

The temperature at which a wine is served will greatly impact its flavor. The ideal temperature varies based on the type of wine.

Follow a ridge with nearly complete tree cover the entire way. The trail connects to the Cactus Rocks Trail and the Sunset Deck and its overlook towards Lake Travis.



BIRD WATCH THE GOLDEN-CHEEKED WARBLER

The golden-cheeked warbler is pretty special around here. As the only species that nests exclusively in Texas, the golden-cheeked warbler calls the local Ashe juniper woodlands home. Declared endangered in 2009, we're careful to keep their habitat a robust and welcoming one.

INKS LAKE STATE PARK



Woodland Trail — 2.2 MILES

A backcountry hike that will take you through oak woodlands, over rocky hills and to beautiful scenic views of Hoover Valley.

Lake Trail — 1.2 MILES

Pecan Flats Trail — 1.8 MILES

This trail section takes hikers to a waterhole lined with rocky cliffs great for jumping into the lake. It also has great views and access to several fishing spots.

This popular trail takes hikers along the creek that feeds into Inks Lake. As you walk along the north shore line, hikers will come across several small waterfalls and beautiful vistas until you reach the wildlife viewing station.

- 9. Westcave Outdoor Discovery Center**
Take a guided birding hike at this lush nature preserve featuring wildlife and a varied landscape.
- 10. Pedernales Falls State Park**
Miles and miles of hiking, equestrian, and backpacking trails, with scenic overlooks and a tranquil river.
- 11. Pedernales River Nature Park**
Over 200 acres of picturesque riverfront for hiking, mountain biking, and water activities.

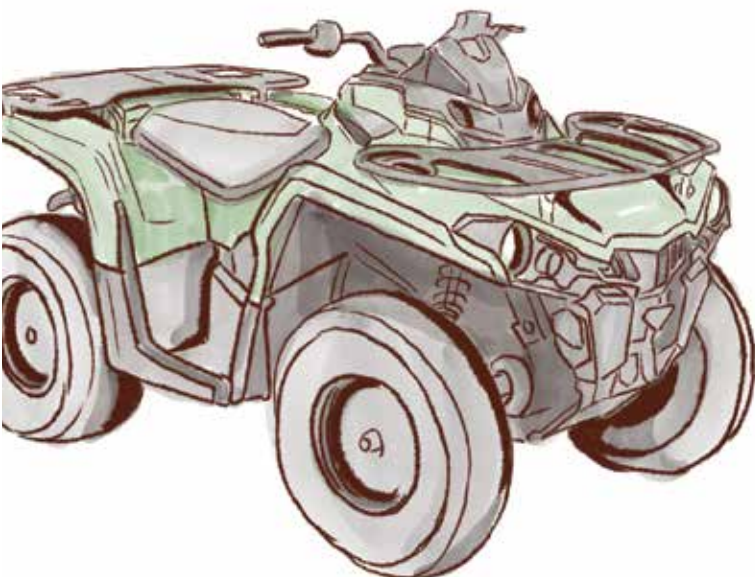

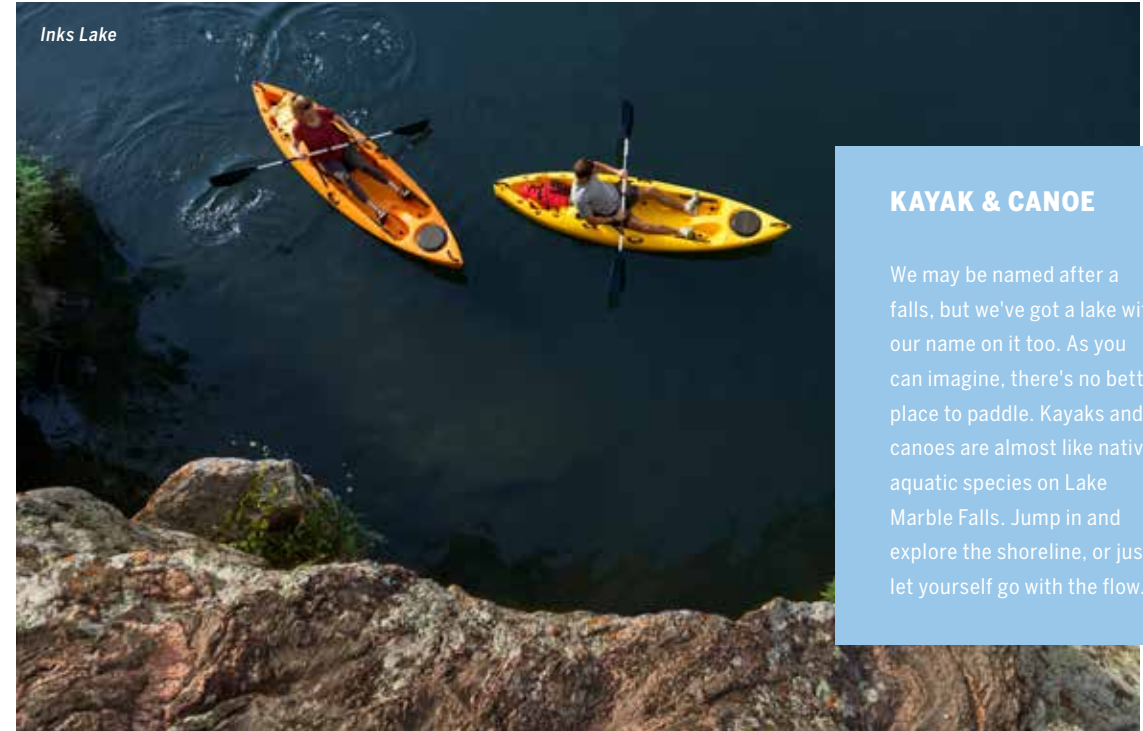

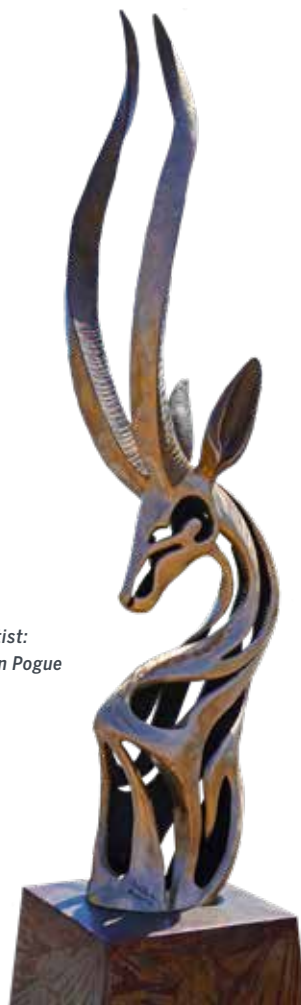
Pieces are solicited from artists from around the southwest. The Board of Highland Lakes Creative Arts (HLCA), the curator of the show, jury pieces in each year.

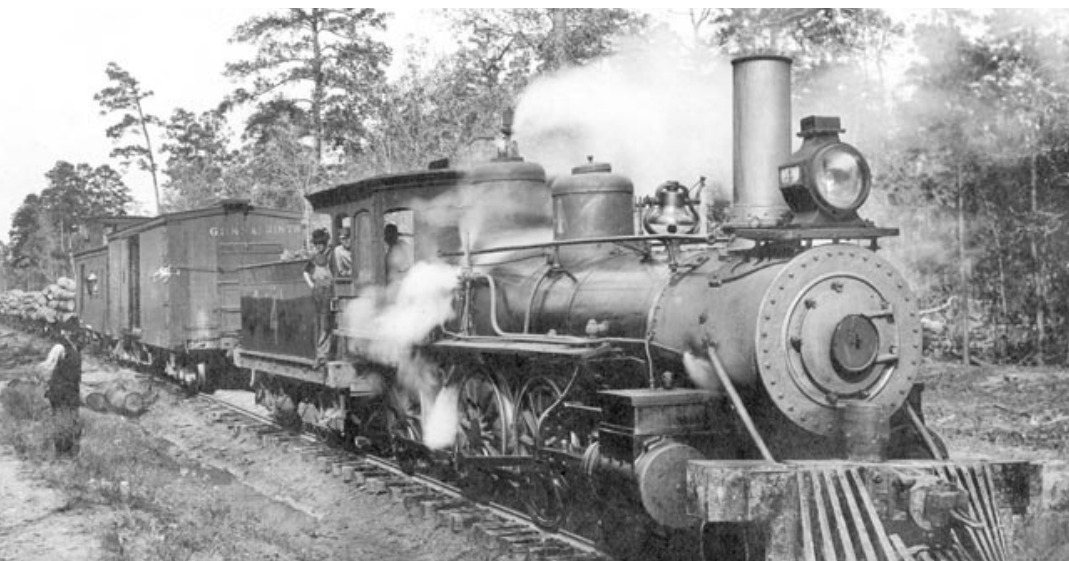

The History of Marble Falls and our Granite

Established in 1887 on the hillside above the Colorado River, Marble Falls quickly became a bustling Hill Country hub. With a population of over 1,800 in just ten years, Marble Falls grew with the vision of industrial commerce powered by the river. The dams that created Lake Marble Falls were fully realized in 1951, and by the 1970s, word got out that Marble Falls was a great place for lakeside tourism and recreation. And today, well, here you are. Welcome!

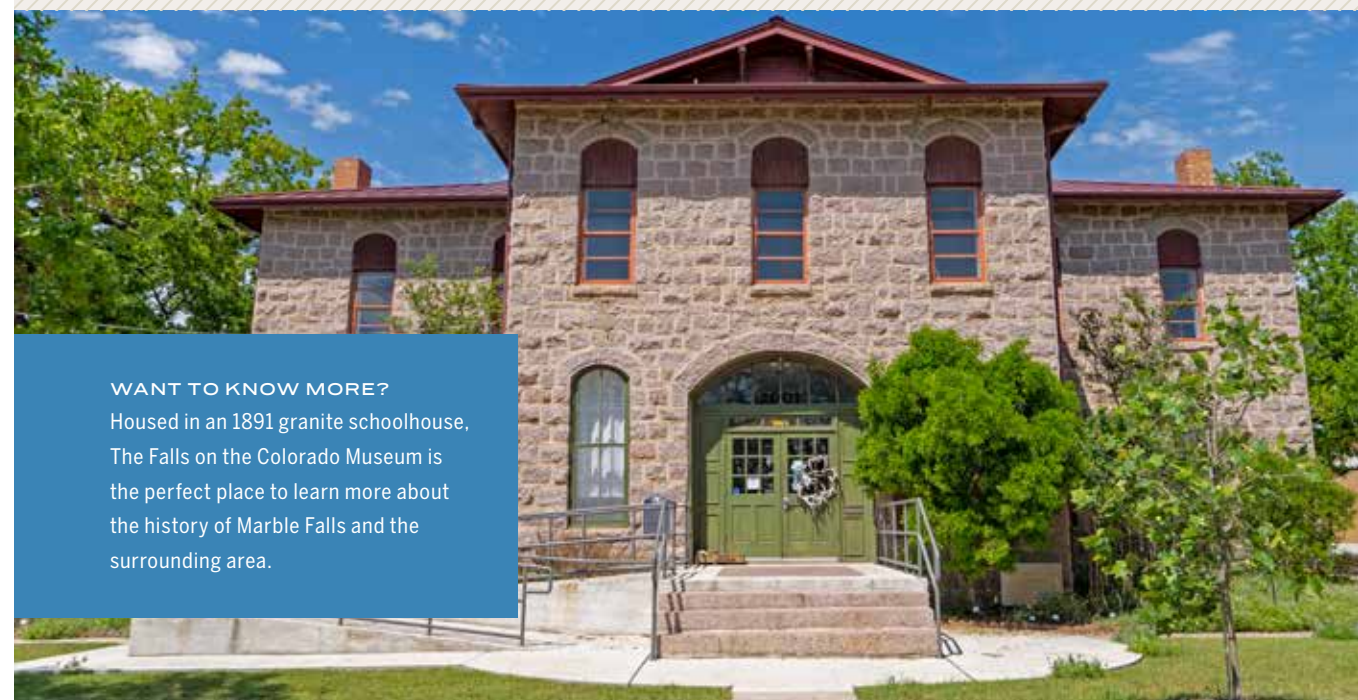


NOT MARBLE, BUT GRANITE

When Visitors come to Marble Falls, they obviously assume our lakeside town sits on marble rock deposits, but we are actually known for our granite. Granite Mountain, located west of town on HWY 1431, was created more than 4.5 billion years ago forming nature's hardest stone and at the time of its discovery, was 866 feet tall. On July 29th, 1885, the town donated its granite to erect the now Texas State Capitol located in Austin, Texas in exchange for a railroad system and labor to mine the rock. 15,700 carloads of granite were transported to the site in Austin and at the time of its completion in 1888, the Texas State Capitol was said to be the seventh largest building in the world. It is the largest capitol state building in the United States today, and only second in size to the National Capitol in Washington D.C. Our granite from Granite Mountain has also been used in the construction of the Coca-Cola Building in Atlanta, Wyndham Hotel in Dallas, the Galveston Seawall, and the Crocker Building in San Francisco, just to name a few. Although the shape of the dome has changed throughout its lifetime, geologists say there are still centuries left in the mining process, and that it is the largest of its kind in the United States.
