

# ORV TRAIL



There are 24 miles of a State ORV route connecting Negaunee Ice Arena with downtown Republic. Parking available at either end. In Ishpeming, follow some city streets (Hematite and Washington Streets) that are open to ORVs 65" and under. Confidence markers are placed along the route. Map boards are at Negaunee Ice Arena, Third Street, Spruce Street and Washington Streets in Ishpeming and downtown Republic.

From Washington Street in Ishpeming to Republic, follow the east/west Greenwood Grade to Humboldt and then follow the north/south Republic Grade (AKA Snowmobile Trail #82) into downtown Republic.

The trail is open to equestrians from Winthrop Junction to Republic.
