

## Run Timing — West Cook Inlet, Palmer, Wasilla, Talkeetna

Deshka River	•	Lower: Late May through late June. Upper: Early June through season close in mid-July. Lower: Mid-July through early August. Upper: Late July through early September.
Alexander Creek	•	Late May through third week of June. Mid-July through August.
Parks Highway streams: Willow Creek, Little Willow Creek, Caswell Creek, Sheep Creek, Goose Creek, Montana Creek,		
	King Salmon Silver Salmon	Kashwitna River, Sunshine Creek.  Late May through early July.  Early August through mid-September.
Susitna River streams	Pink Salmon	Early June through late June.  Mid-July through mid-August, but not very abundant in this area.  Late July through mid-August.  Early July through mid-August, greatest abundance on even-numbered years.  Mid-July through mid-August, but not very abundant in this area.
Lake Creek (Yentna River)	0	Early June through early July. Early August through late August / early September.
Talachulitna River	0	Lower: June. Upper: mid-June through season close in mid-July.  Lower: August. Upper: mid-August through mid-September.
Talkeetna River	0	Mid-June through season closure in mid-July. Early August through September
Little Susitna River	0	Lower: Late May through late June. Upper: mid-June through season close in mid-July. Lower: Mid-July through mid-August. Upper: early August through early September. Mid-July through early August.
Western Cook Inlet drainages: Chuitna River, Beluga River, Theodore River, Lewis River, McArthur River, Kustatan River		
	•	Late May through season close in late June. Mid-July through early September.
