

MANSIONS OF MILLEDGEVILLE: Milledgeville, GEORGIA FULL DAY ITINERARY

Named one of Southern Living's 2017 "Prettiest Small Towns," Milledgeville is home to a charming downtown district, iconic landmarks and beautiful antebellum architecture synonymous with the American South.

10:00-10:45 am

Begin your day with a tour of **Rose Hill**, a lovely Greek revival style home built in 1852, situated on over 50 acres of beautiful landscapes at Lockerly Arboretum.

11:00 am - 12:00 pm

Tour **Georgia's Old Governors Mansion**, one of the finest examples of High Greek Revival architecture in the nation. Today it has been meticulously restored and serves as the Smithsonian's only historic home affiliate in Georgia.

12:00- 1:30 pm

Experience Milledgeville's rich history while cruising around town on the city's most iconic form of transportation, **Milly the Trolley**. Guests will explore the landmark historic district as well as guided tours of private sites including the Old State Capitol, St. Stephens Episcopal Church and the Brown–Stetson–Sanford House.

1:30 pm

Enjoy lunch at one of our many restaurants located in the center of the historical district in downtown Milledgeville. After lunch enjoy the many shops and boutiques of our downtown area.

4:00 — 5:00 pm

Tour **Andalusia Farm**, a picturesque farm amid 544 acres that served as the home of famed Southern author Flannery O'Connor. During the 13 years she lived at Andalusia, O'Connor completed the majority of her literary work, as the farm's environment influenced the setting of many of her writings.
