YEARLONG WEDDING CHECKLIST

SIX TO TWELVE MONTHS

- 1. Announce your engagement. Have someone throw you a party and send an engagement announcement to your local newspaper.
- Decide on what kind of wedding you will have. Less formal = morning or early afternoon. More formal = late afternoon or evening.
- Decide on the time of day. Are you
 prepared to feed your guests dinner
 or do you want a simple ceremony
 with cake and punch only? The time
 of day that you choose will dictate
 the food choices.
- Choose a location. Remember to take into consideration what the weather could be like on your wedding day.
- 5. Pick a date. Do this as soon as possible so that your bridal party and faraway family can begin making arrangements for motels and scheduling time away from their family. Consider a "Save the Date" mailing.
- 6. Set a budget. Discuss carefully between the two of you and your respective families.
- Select the bridal party. It is important to do this as soon as possible so these special people can set aside time to fulfill their duties and roles in your wedding.
- 8. Choose your colors. Your flowers, attire, linens, decorations, and cake will reflect your choice. Since you have to shop for these items fairly far in advance, it's important that your choice is firm.
- Choose and order your gown, bridesmaids' gowns and accessories.
- 10.Start planning the honeymoon.
- 11. Begin your bridal registry. Visit your favorite stores and choose items that you will need to start your life together.
- 12. Select caterer, photographer, florist, and musicians. Keep their phone numbers handy.
- 13. Start planning the reception. Secure a venue that suits you for your reception area.
- 14. Start premarital counseling. Some churches require this for marriage.
- 15. Choose and order wedding rings.

THREE MONTHS

- 1. Complete guest list.
- 2. Mothers should select their dresses. Traditionally, the mother of the bride selects first.
- 3. Finalize the reception, particularly any rentals.
- Make honeymoon reservations. Always mention that this is a honeymoon. You will be surprised how many perks you will get.
- Confirm dates and times with florist, caterer, photographer, musicians, and church (if applicable).
- 6. Discuss transportation to and from wedding and reception sites.
- 7. Order wedding cake.
- 8. Choose and order tuxes.
- 9. Schedule bridesmaids' dress fittings. Choose and dye shoes if necessary.
- 10. Arrange room block for out-of-town guests at local hotel or resort.
- 11. Schedule salon appointments for wedding day, if needed.

TWO MONTHS

- 1. Mail the invitations
- 2. Finalize the honeymoon plans.
- Choose rehearsal dinner location.
 This is traditionally the responsibility of the groom and his family.

ONE MONTH

- Reserve accommodations for special guests.
- Record gifts received before wedding and send thank-you notes immediately.
- 3. Plan the rehearsal and dinner. This is traditionally the responsibility of the groom and his family, but all should work together on this.
- 4. Purchase gifts for the bridal party.
- 5. Schedule final fittings for bride and bridesmaids.
- Purchase a guest book and decide where it will go — wedding venue or reception. Choose attendant to stand nearby and invite guests to sign the book.
- Get the marriage license. Licenses can be applied for no more than 30 days before the marriage. Contact county clerk for additional information.

TWO WEEKS

- 1. Finalize wedding day transportation.
- 2. Plan seating arrangement for reception.

ONE WEEK

- Start packing for the honeymoon. Be sure to choose clothing that you won't need during this very busy week.
- 2. Finalize the number of guests with the caterer.
- 3. Make sure that wedding rings are picked up and fitted
- Touch base with florist, caterer, photographer, musicians, and wedding venue for any last minute questions.
