

No Live Music/Entertainment per California Department of Public Health Guidance

The Monterey County Health Department would like to remind all food facilities that live music and entertainment is **not** allowed under the current guidance issued by the California Department of Public Health. Establishments that serve full meals associated with outdoor dining experiences must discontinue this type of entertainment until they are allowed to resume modified or full operation through a specific reopening order or guidance. In addition, live music or entertainment is not allowed at any public gatherings or community events under the current guidance issued by the California Department of Public Health.
