Dr. Tom Moore has been involved with soccer as a player, manager and referee. While on active duty in the U.S. Army, in 1978, Tom joined the Fort Lee, VA men's soccer team that played in the Central Virginia Soccer League. A year later he became the team captain and also went on to serve a year as Vice President of the league.

He moved to Virginia Tech when he left active duty in 1980 and discovered that there was no organized adult soccer in the area except for the Virginia Tech team itself. So, in 1981, Tom, his brother Alan and Cary Green, the Assistant Coach at Virginia Tech, formed the Southwest Virginia Soccer Association. Within three years they had 24 adult teams in two men's divisions and one women's division. From 1984-1985, Tom also served as the Vice President of the Metro DC – Virginia Soccer Association, which promotes adult amateur soccer for the U.S. Soccer Federation (USSF) in the Commonwealth of Virginia and the District of Columbia.

In 1986, Tom moved to Monterey, CA for work and began to play for the Naval Postgraduate School team that plays in the Monterey Peninsula Soccer League (MPSL). In 1987, Tom became President of the MPSL and still serves in that capacity. In 1993, the MPSL became a member league in the California Soccer Association North (CSAN) and Tom began serving on its Board of Directors. In 2018, Tom was elected President and CEO of CSAN. He also served for several years as the Manager of the CSAN Men's Select Team and on the Technology Committee and the Governance Committee of the U.S. Adult Soccer Association (USASA).

In addition to being a league and a State Association President, since 2020 Tom has served as Deputy Director of Region 4 of the U.S. Adult Soccer Association. In these various capacities, he has been a delegate to National Council meetings of the USASA and the USSF for more than 15 years.

Tom has also served soccer as a referee. He obtained his first USSF Referee license in 1980 and has renewed his license every year since then. He rose in referee rank to become a State Referee I and has also held USSF licenses as a Referee Instructor, Referee Assessor and Referee Assignor. He has been a high school referee for more than 20 years, and has been a member of the West Coast Intercollegiate Referee Association since 1996. He has officiated games at Stanford University, San Jose State, Santa Clara University and all of the Community Colleges and universities with soccer teams in Monterey and Santa Cruz counties.

In his day job, Dr. Moore has taught for nearly 30 years at the Naval Postgraduate School. He is married to a long-suffering soccer widow, Dr. Monique Fargues.
