

Virg's Landing Red (Vermillion) Tournament

Months of April & May 2020

Virg's will award a season pass to the customer that catches the largest vermillion rockfish in **April**. We will also award a pass for the largest caught in **May**.

#1 - Qualifying fish are Vermillion Rockfish ONLY. The boat crew will determine that the largest fish is indeed a vermillion, as there are different varieties in coloring.

#2 – **Only day trip anglers may qualify.** Overnight, 1.5 Day and 2 Day trip anglers are excluded from the competition.

#3 – The largest fish (or fishes, if they are close in weight) for each boat each day will be weighed by a crew member on land to determine the exact weight.

#4 - Once a fish has been brought aboard the boat, it becomes one of the angler's ten rockfish limit.

#5 - There can be no trading or passing off of a fish from one angler to another, and no illegal fishing methods used (i.e. more than 2 hooks, more than one rod, etc.) All Fish & Wildlife regulations for rockfish apply to this tournament!!!

#6 - The fish must be intact & whole, not bled, gutted, or missing parts.

#7 – If there is an object in a fish's mouth (baitfish, octopus, etc.) and it can be removed by hand, it will not be counted as part of the fish weight.

#8 – After weigh-in, fish stomach contents will be examined to prevent cheating.

#9 – If the case of a tie at the end of the qualifying month, a fish-off (to be determined by Virg's) will be held.

#10 - All decisions by Virg's Landing are final.
