

# Maritime & Lighthouse



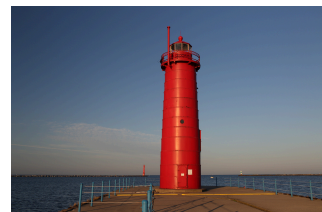
Immerse yourselves in Muskegon's rich history, explore iconic ships, and experience our beautiful beaches--all in one unforgettable morning.

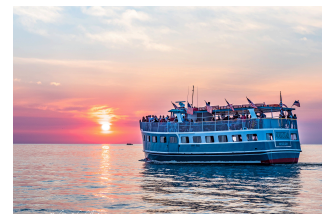
