Cap it off by bringing your lunch into the Channel View Room while enjoying scenic views of passing boats at the Cross-Lake Ferry!

Step back in time at the Hackley & Hume Historic Site. Tour the grand homes of Muskegon's lumber baron, Charles Hackley, and his partner, Thomas Hume. Original samples and photographic evidence were used to recreate every detail of these phenomenal late 19th and early 20th century Queen Anne style homes.





Your next stop is the USS LST 393 Veterans Museum. This WWII hero, a Landing Ship Tank used on Omaha Beach, is one of only two left in the US! Explore its decks, feel the weight of history, and see why it earned three battle stars.
