



The day begins on the farm, Lewis Farm! Take a narrated wagon ride (handicap accessible) through the sunflower fields. Those with a flair for adventure must experience the 6-acre Corn Maze. Explore what fall tastes like as you taste and learn about the 25 varieties of apples grown on the farm. Pick your own apples or just find a few to take with you from the Farm Market. Home baked goods are also for sale at the Farm Market and Bakery, where you can try a tasty fudge sample for those with a sweet tooth. Cheer for the pigs at the Pig Race Show and then become friends with the birds at the aviary. The farm has animals to pet and feed too.

Experience the colors of autumn on the ride weaving through the fall foliage and the scenic waves of Lake Michigan. Stop at Muskegon's own Block House, to experience the best view of the lake from the highest point in Muskegon.

Tour the historical homes of Muskegon's founding lumber barons, Hackley and Hume. This guided tour takes you back to the late 1800's when Muskegon's lumber barons were the wealthiest in the United States. The Queen Anne style Hackley home features extensive woodwork, where thirteen woodcarvers' hand-carved virtually the entire interior.
