Track chair and beach chair opportunities!

Muskegon State Park's track chair and beach chair program helps provide accessibility to the park's beaches and trails.

Cost

Use of the track chair or beach chair is free of charge, and is available on a first-come, first-reserved basis. Track chairs were generously donated by Kali's Cure for Paralysis Foundation.

Reservations

The track chair or beach chair may be reserved by contacting the park office during business hours (Monday – Friday from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.)

Park entry

The chairs may be used through most of the park. When making a reservation you will be asked the area you would like to use the chair so staff can deliver it to the general area of use. A Recreation Passport is required on all vehicles entering the park. Recreation Passports may be purchased at the Michigan Secretary of State offices or at park entrances.

Safety and rules

Service animals are welcome but must be under the control of their handler or a companion at all times. Visitors with pets must adhere to the state park rules regarding pets. Be advised that leashes, long clothing, blankets or other dangling items (i.e. camera straps, etc.) are at risk of becoming entangled in the chairs. All track chair or beach chair users must sign a waiver of liability.

What to bring

You may want to bring water, weather-appropriate clothing, a seat cushion, a hat, sunblock, sunglasses, snacks or a camera.
