# Day 1:

## BREAKFAST:

<u>Croissants Bakery & Bistro</u> (Opens at 7 a.m.) *Croissants offers Southern comfort food, baked goods and fresh coffee--all with a French bistro flare.* Two locations: 3751 Robert M Grissom Pkwy, Myrtle Beach or 8014 North Kings Highway Pkwy, Myrtle Beach

Explore the Myrtle Beach Boardwalk and Promenade And ride the <u>SkyWheel</u>, 1110 N Ocean Blvd, Myrtle Beach *The 1.2-mile-long Boardwalk packed with family-friendly shops, restaurants and arcades, and is also home to the SkyWheel – a 187-foot observation wheel overlooking the Atlantic Ocean, offering 42 glass-enclosed, climatecontrolled gondolas that seat up to six people.*
