Day 1:

BREAKFAST:

Croissants Bakery & Bistro (Opens at 7 a.m.)

Croissants offers Southern comfort food, baked goods and fresh coffee--all with a French bistro flare. Two locations:

Morning activity:

Hit the beach! It's 60 miles long, so you'll have no trouble finding a great place to set up for the morning. If you're staying at a beach-front resort, you're likely to have pools, hot tubs, lazy rivers and/or waterparks to enjoy as well.

LUNCH:

Loco Gecko Beach Shak, 805 S. Ocean Blvd, Myrtle Beach

Loco Gecko offers a casual dining experience with delectable burgers, wings and pizza as well as healthier options such as fresh wraps and salads.

Afternoon activity:



Take a relaxing kayak tour of the Waccamaw River with <u>J&L Kayaks, LLC</u>, Little River, SC (Check website and make reservations in advance.)

Eco-tourism by kayak with experienced guides. Their equipment is the best in the area and has been hand selected for quality, stability, comfort, safety, and overall functionality. Enjoy a kayak adventure!

OR

If you're more of a landlubber, head a bit farther north, just over the state line to take an ATV tour with Carolinabackwoods, 1461 Ash Little River Rd NW, Ash, NC 28420

They are the #1 ATV tour destination in the Myrtle Beach area for the past 6 years. Carolinabackwoods is a family run business with guided tours designed for everyone to have fun. No experience required.

While you're in Little River, stop at Twelve 33 Distillery

The Myrtle Beach area's first craft distillery opened in Little River in May 2019. Named Twelve 33 after the end of prohibition in the U.S. in December 1933, it includes an infusion room for spirits and a hidden speakeasy. They are currently making Vodka, Rye Whiskey, Bourbon Whiskey and Rum.

If wine is more to your liking, try a tasting at the lovely <u>La Belle Amie Vineyard</u>, 1120 St Joseph Road, Little River, SC 29566

Evening dinner:

Ruth's Chris Steak House, 8211 Marina Pkwy, Grande Dunes Blvd, Myrtle Beach While there are countless restaurant options in Myrtle Beach, Ruth's Chris is one of the top choices when it comes to fine dining. Treat yourself to a special, sophisticated meal at Ruth's Chris!

Day 2:

BREAKFAST:

Morning activity:

Spend your morning exploring the gorgeous <u>Brookgreen Gardens</u>, 1931 Brookgreen Garden Dr, Murrells Inlet (About 30 minutes south of Myrtle Beach.)

Every day, Brookgreen offers a selection of tours, programs, and exhibits for all ages. You may stroll through the gardens on a guided tour or explore these beautiful spaces on your own. Each season, new exhibitions and special events make Brookgreen Gardens...Ever Changing. Simply Amazing.

OR

Take a tour of <u>Huntington Beach State Park</u>, 16148 Ocean HWY, Murrells Inlet, SC

Hike or tour on a Segway with <u>Myrtle Beach Segway</u> (Tours sell out, so book in advance!)

Huntington is home to some of the top bird-watching on the East Coast. There's also Atalaya, the picturesque, Moorish-style winter home of Archer and Anna Hyatt Huntington, philanthropist and sculptor, respectively, who left the park and adjacent Brookgreen



Gardens as their legacy. The park offers nature programs, and the freshwater lake is a sure-fire place to see alligators and sometimes even a mink or two.

LUNCH:

<u>Drunken Jack's</u>, 4031 Hwy. 17, Business, Murrells Inlet, SC

Enjoy craft beers, entertainment and award-winning food, including the freshest seafood imaginable..

The sprawling patio allows diners to take in the panoramic view of the Inlet including Goat Island, home to goats and their peacock friends.

Afternoon activity:

Start with some wine tasting at <u>Duplin Winery</u>, 4650 Hwy 17 S, North Myrtle Beach *Duplin winery has a tank capacity of over 1.8 million gallons and sells over 500,000 cases of wine annually. All Duplin wines are cold fermented to preserve the natural sweetness that only muscadine grapes can produce. Great atmosphere and a beautiful gift shop.*

DINNER:
