As vice chancellor for research, Dr. Jon Mogford works in close collaboration with The Texas A&M University System's 11 universities, seven state agencies, and health science center to facilitate the growth of research of all system members. As the leader of the A&M System Office of Research, he is responsible for providing services and support to all 19 system members in areas including research development and research compliance. Previous to his present position, he was Associate Vice Chancellor, Office of Strategic Initiatives, The Texas A&M University System, having joined that office from the Defense Advanced Research Projects Agency, where he was the Acting Director of the Defense Sciences Office (DSO). Dr. Mogford has an extensive background in biology research and its applications in the field of defense medicine and therapeutics. His expertise encompasses wound healing/regeneration, cellular therapies, tissue engineering and vascular physiology. His specific interests focus on therapeutics for wounded soldiers, protein design processes and drug delivery.

Dr. Mogford obtained his bachelor's degree in Zoology from Texas A&M University and doctorate in Medical Physiology from the Texas A&M University Health Science Center, College Station, Texas. His research in vascular physiology continued at the University of Chicago as a Postdoctoral fellow from 1997-98. Dr. Mogford transitioned his research focus to the field of wound healing at Northwestern University, both as a Research Associate and also as a Research Assistant Professor from 1998-2003. Dr. Mogford is married to Tammy Mogford and has twin sons, Christian and Zachary.
