# 3rd Fiscal Quarter Report

April - June 2018



## River Education Kicks-Off Water Recreation Season

Enclosed are the financial report and budget status update on expenditures of occupancy tax revenues, along with activity highlights of this 3-month period.

The Texas Hotel Reporting Factbook Hotel Occupancy Tax collections reflect a 7.6% increase over April, May, June of 2017. City Hotel Occupancy revenue reflect a decrease of 3.82% for the same quarter. We attribute this discrepancy to the sharing/investment economy property segment growth, which does not contribute to the local hotel tax.

The River Street Teams Activated on May 19<sup>th</sup> and operated through July. Over 25 team members, staged at 3 locations distributed over 13,000 complimentary non-disposable containers. The activation achieved its goal of reaching people early in the season. Over Memorial Day weekend, over 4,000 cups were distributed. Cup distribution continued to be high in June.







Twice a year the Chamber's CVB partners with local school districts and museums to engage and highlight educators and students on various topics of New Braunfels history. Over 5,000 complimentary non-disposable containers were handed out to river-goers within the first 2 weeks, including Memorial Day. As the season progressed the teams continued education and outreach to ensure an enjoyable experience, all while helping protect the environment. The teams were positioned at Prince Solms Park and Elizabeth Ave on the weekends, intercepting floaters before they hit the water.


