TV Documentary

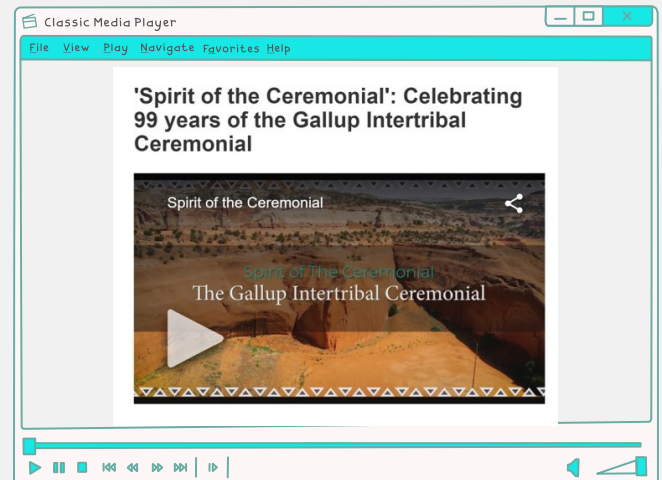
