1. Do not engage with anyone on the street who asks you strange questions
2. Don't wander down dark alleys with strangers
3. Make sure to put your wallet in your front pocket and don't leave a purse hanging on a chair
4. Do not wear your badge/credentials outside of the hotel
5. Know where you are going and how to get back to the hotel
6. Take a taxi/Uber at night if you're not close to your hotel
7. Keep your valuables safe in the hotel
8. Make sure you know the hotel phone number
9. Don't wander off the beaten path at night
10. Don't over indulge in alcohol
11. Don't flash cash around
12. Don't go wandering around unfamiliar streets at 1:00 in the morning
13. Do not leave the hotel alone and always have a companion with you. If you do decide to leave alone, make sure someone knows where you are going and when you intend to get back
