Option 1: Newport News + Virginia International Tattoo in Norfolk

MORNING

Breakfast at Indulge Bakery & Bistro

Virginia War Museum

MORNING

Breakfast at Sage Kitchen

Virginia War Museum

Victory Landing Park @ Victory Arch

LUNCH

Smoke BBQ Resturant & Bar

Refuel with a delicious meal at Smoke BBQ, known for its tender brisket, pulled pork, and classic Southern sides like mac and cheese and collard greens.

AFTFRNOON

The Mariners' Museum and Park

Step into the world of naval history at one of the largest maritime museums in the U.S. Explore the legendary USS Monitor Center, where over 200 tons of artifacts from the Civil War ironclad are preserved, including its revolutionary rotating gun turret. Interactive exhibits and ship models make this a must-visit for history enthusiasts.

Noland Trail Walk

After your museum visit, take a scenic walk along the Noland Trail, a five-mile loop that winds through Mariners' Park. Featuring 14 picturesque wooden bridges and breathtaking views of Mariners' Lake, this trail offers a relaxing way to enjoy Newport News' natural beauty.

EVENING

Dinner at Harpoon Larry's Fish House & Oyster Bar

End the day with a seafood feast at this casual yet lively restaurant. Enjoy fresh oysters, crab cakes, shrimp platters, and signature seafood boils.

Dessert & Fountain Stroll at City Center

Wrap up your night with a leisurely walk around City Center at Oyster Point. Stop by for ice cream or dessert while enjoying the peaceful ambiance of the fountain and litup streets.
