





# Parks & Nature

No matter what kind of outdoor adventure you're after, Newport News has something for everyone.

With a mild climate and dozens of beautiful parks and natural spaces, it's the perfect year-round destination for exploring.

Hit the trails for an exhilarating bike ride, enjoy a romantic paddle on the water, or challenge yourself with a round of golf. Reserve one of 188 modern campsites at Newport News Park, pack a picnic by the James River at sunset, or stroll along our scenic beaches. You can also spot local wildlife, play a round of disc golf, or cast a line—our lakes, reservoirs, and the Chesapeake Bay offer some of the best saltwater and freshwater fishing in Virginia. Come discover the outdoors, Newport News style!

FORT FUN AT HUNTINGTON PARK

**Deer Park:** 11523 Jefferson Ave.— With nearly 13 acres of woodlands and hiking trails, Deer Park offers a Boundless Play-ground (universally accessible so children can play side-by-side), two lighted ballfields, three picnic shelters, and freshwater fishing in an interior lake.

**Denbigh Boat Ramp Park:** 10 Denbigh Blvd. – This 13.3-acre marshland park sits along the peaceful Warwick River and features a newly rebuilt fishing pier and boat ramp—perfect for anglers and boaters alike. The park also includes a nature trail where visitors can spot local wildlife and enjoy a quiet, natural escape.

**Huntington Park:** 9285 Warwick Blvd. – This 60-acre park features a public beach and boat ramp, rose garden, picnic shelters, ballfields, and Fort Fun, a 14,000 sq. ft. playground that overlooks the James River. The park also includes a tennis center that offers pickleball and tennis courts, ball machine and backboard rentals. Fishing available at Lake Biggins.

**King-Lincoln Park:** 600 Jefferson Ave. – Overlooking the Hampton Roads waterfront at the southeast end of Newport News, King-Lincoln Park features tennis, basketball, picnicking, playgrounds, a saltwater fishing pier and an interpretive center (open during summer months, weekends only).

RIVERVIEW FARM PARK

**Riverview Farm Park:** 105 City Farm Rd. – Home to Fido Field dog park and Fantasy Farm playground, Riverview Farm Park also offers picnic shelters, soccer field, concession stand (open weekends, April through October), two miles of paved multi-use trails, and a trail leading to the shore of the Warwick River.

**Stoney Run Park:** 15194 Warwick Blvd. – A welcoming green space perfect for visitors looking to enjoy Newport News’ active side. This five-field complex hosts sports leagues and tournaments throughout the year. While it’s best known for softball, the park also accommodates youth baseball, soccer, and field hockey—making it a lively spot for families, spectators, and anyone who enjoys a day outdoors.

**Leeward Marina:** 7499 River Rd. – Leeward Marina is a favorite access point for exploring Newport News by water. With floating docks, sturdy seawalls, and convenient fuel sales, it’s well-equipped for vessels up to 43 feet. Whether you’re setting out for a day on the river or simply enjoying the marina atmosphere, it’s a great place to start your adventure.

**Newport News Park:** 13560 Jefferson Ave. – One of the largest municipal parks east of the Mississippi, spanning 7,711 acres, and offering hiking and biking trails, picnic shelters, boat rentals, golf, archery and fishing. Visitors can camp year-round at 188 sites and explore lush woodlands, lakes, and wildlife. The park also features a Discovery Center, disc golf, and historical landmarks.



VICTORY LANDING PARK

**Victory Landing Park:** 50 26th St. – This 5.44-acre riverfront gem offers some of the best James River views in the city. It’s an ideal place for a scenic sunset stroll as you watch aircraft carriers, submarines, boats, and other impressive vessels glide by from the nearby shipyard. A great stop for anyone who loves waterfront scenery and maritime sights.





**Tradition Brewing Company**, the city's first craft brewery, celebrates Newport News history while inspiring new traditions with each pour.

**Coastal Fermentory**, launched by three engineers with a passion for brewing, has grown from home-brewing experiments to two locations, including a new spot near Newport News/Williamsburg Airport.

At **1700 Brewing**, a veteran-owned nano-brewery, you'll find small-batch creations that honor heroes past and present.

Beyond house-made brews, **Bird Girl Bottle Shop** provides a welcoming beer garden with craft beers, wine, and "wild" pizzas.

**Corkscrews & Brews**, in the Yard District, combines coffee, wine, and light bites – such as charcuterie boards.

**Beervana Taphouse** offers 42 self-pour taps paired with specialty burgers. **TINTO** showcases rare wines from family-run vineyards worldwide, with tasting events and tapas.

**Chef's Market Food Hall & Entertainment Venue** features a wide range of entertainment, dining and libations under one roof. Our multi-faceted establishment is THE PLACE to eat, drink and be merry.


