Start your day at Newport's newest museum, **The Sailing Museum**. This one-of-akind, interactive museum opened its doors in 2022 to the anticipation of sailors and non-sailors alike. High-tech exhibits allow visitors to create an avatar, design a boat, steer with both tiller and wheel, and race against others. Visitors of all ages experience the magic that happens when wind and water meet.

Enjoy a sail on the **Aurora** — a 101-foot classic schooner that accommodates large groups. This sailing experience features views of iconic lighthouses, public and private estates, as well as the iconic Newport Pell Bridge. For an optional outing, choose from a variety of narrated Newport Harbor cruises.

visit ► The Newport area sports two incredible automobile museums: The Audrain Automobile Museum and the Newport Car Museum. The Audrain Automobile Museum changes its showroom throughout the year utilizing its collection of more than 350 cars and motorcycles. The Newport Car Museum, in nearby Portsmouth, showcases six different galleries featuring cars from the 1950s to the present. They also offer an extensive gift shop with unique and fun car-related items.

refresh ► Choose one of our unique locations for lunch:

- La Forge Casino Restaurant, in the same historic block as the Audrain Automobile Museum, offers dining with views of the grass courts at the International Tennis Hall of Fame.
- Catered box lunch in a private room at the Newport Car Museum.

Enjoy a pedal-powered bike that travels along the train tracks offering views of Mount Hope Bridge and Narragansett Bay. The bikes are easy to pedal, and the terrain is mostly flat, which allows for an enjoyable trip for all ages and abilities.
