tour ▶ Start your day at a museum with deep roots to Newport’s history, **The Sailing Museum & National Sailing Hall of Fame**. This one-of-a-kind, interactive museum opened its doors in 2022 to the anticipation of sailors and non-sailors alike. High-tech exhibits allow visitors to create an avatar, design a boat, steer with both tiller and wheel, and race against others. Visitors of all ages experience the magic that happens when wind and water meet.

sail ▶ Enjoy a sail on the **Aurora** – with her stunning red masts, the 101-foot classic schooner can accommodate large groups. New this 2025 season, the **Adirondeck IV** hosts up to 70 guests. Experience views of iconic lighthouses, public and private estates, as well as the iconic Newport Pell Bridge. For an optional outing, choose from a variety of narrated Newport Harbor cruises.

visit ▶ The Newport area sports two incredible automobile museums: The Audrain Automobile Museum and the Newport Car Museum. The **Audrain Automobile Museum** changes its showroom throughout the year utilizing its collection of more than 350 cars and motorcycles. The **Newport Car Museum**, in nearby Portsmouth, showcases seven different galleries featuring over 100 cars from the 1950s to the present. They also offer an extensive gift shop with unique and fun car-related items.

refresh ▶ Choose one of our unique locations for lunch:

- **La Forge Casino Restaurant**, in the same historic block as the Audrain Automobile Museum, offers dining with views of the grass courts at the International Tennis Hall of Fame.
- Catered box lunch in a private room at the **Newport Car Museum**.

ride ▶ Get moving with **Rail Explorers**, a great way to explore the Old Colony Railroad. Enjoy a pedal-powered bike that travels along the train tracks offering views of Mount Hope Bridge and Narragansett Bay. The bikes are easy to pedal, and the terrain is mostly flat, which allows for an enjoyable trip for all ages and abilities. Lantern, Fireside, and Waterfront Picnic area tours available.

shop ▶ Take time to browse the local shops in **Bowen’s and Bannister’s Wharves**, **Brick Market Place**, and **Thames Street**. Visit the **Newport Mansions Store** on Bannister’s Wharf and find something unique to remember your visit.
