- Drive by stunning locations where the HBO Series, "The Gilded Age," was filmed in Newport. (Season 3 will be released soon!)
- Meet the Grande Dame of Newport Society as local step-on guide, Betty Czech, dresses the part of Mrs. Caroline Astor for her own 19th century city tour.
- ➤ Tour the opulent Marble House, the "summer cottage" of Mr. & Mrs. William K. Vanderbilt. The 1892 mansion, designed by renowned architect Richard Morris Hunt, has over 500,000 cubic feet of marble. Alva Vanderbilt would later host rallies for women's right to vote at the Marble House and Chinese Tea House (built on the property).
- Add a unique experience with an "Afternoon Tea" at the **Chinese Tea House** (seasonal, weekday suggested)

Dining at a local group-friendly restaurant. Some options include lunch at La Forge Casino Restaurant, overlooking the historic International Tennis Hall of Fame grounds, or Johnny's Restaurant at the Wyndham Newport Hotel.
