Step-by-Step Guide: How to Submit a Public Comment to BOEM on Offshore Drilling

What's Happening

The **Bureau of Ocean Energy Management (BOEM)** is preparing the **11th National Outer Continental Shelf Oil and Gas Leasing Program**, which will replace the current 2024– 2029 plan. BOEM is now requesting **public comments** on whether, where, and how offshore oil and gas drilling should proceed.

This is a critical opportunity for communities, businesses, and leaders to voice support for protecting their coastal economies, ecosystems, and quality of life.

Who Should Comment

- Coastal business owners (tourism, hospitality, fishing, etc.)
- Chambers of commerce and business groups
- Local elected officials (mayors, councilmembers, county commissions)
- Environmental organizations
- Concerned residents and families
- Tribes and Tribal organizations

Deadline

Comments must be received by June 16, 2025 at 11:59 PM EST.

How to Submit a Comment

Option 1: Submit Online (Preferred)
