

HISTORIC OMAHA TOUR

History comes alive in Omaha. Swivel up to an old-fashioned soda fountain and enjoy a phosphate at The Durham Museum, Omaha's historic Art Deco train station. Visit the home of Civil War General George Crook and experience life as a frontier hero. Learn about the struggles and triumphs of the Mormon pioneers during their winter migration in 1846. Stroll around the Boys Town campus and feel the spiritual impact Father Edward Flanagan continues to make on the world. OMAHA'S HISTORIC RAILROAD TOUR

Hop aboard history in the city where President Abraham Lincoln started the transcontinental railroad. Omaha is home to one of the first Art Deco train stations in the country, The Durham Museum, where groups can step back in time and get on board President Harry S. Truman's press train.

Two of the most powerful locomotives ever built greet tour groups at Lauritzen Gardens, which also boasts a fascinating outdoor model railroad garden. See artifacts at the Union Pacific Railroad Museum, including a dining, lounge and coach car, china collection, vintage uniforms, menus and furniture from the nation's first transcontinental railroad.
