



With non-stop service to 34 of the nation's busiest airports, flights to and from Omaha are short and sweet – only two-and-a-half hours from either coast. Omaha's airport (OMA) is served by all the major airlines and offers more than 200 arrivals and departures daily.

Let's face it, steak is in Omaha's DNA. If you're looking for a marbled slice of decadence, a cut of beef that you'll remember like it was a birthday gift, then travel to the city known nationwide for doing steak like no other. With an industry dating back to the 1880s, Omaha's cow-know-how is evident by the passion and dedication of the city's many established steakhouses.

And while Omaha is legendary for steak, did you know we've been raising the Reuben sandwich since the beginning? That's right, the Reuben was invented in Omaha (we don't care what those New Yorkers say). Created in the 1900s at Omaha's Blackstone Hotel during a high stakes poker game, a local grocer was asked to "ante up" and create a new dish. The ingredients he had on hand resulted into an American menu staple. Two pieces of grilled marble rye, stuffed with slow-cooked corned beef topped with sauerkraut, bubbly Swiss cheese, and creamy Russian (or Thousand Island) dressing. Many have tried to replicate it, but everyone knows you should always travel for the original.

When thinking about Omaha's agricultural background and central location, it makes sense that the city would be on the forefront of the fresh food movement. New and classic Omaha restaurants have dedicated their kitchens and menus to showcasing the best meat and produce from local farms.



Whether it's the light zest of a cold ale, the mild flavor of a frosty lager, or the heavy malt taste of a dark stout, Omaha is gaining national recognition as a top beer city. True craft beer is all about innovative brewing ingredients, the re-interpretation of traditional methods, and the development of new styles. 

In Omaha it starts just blocks away from the convention center in the Old Market Entertainment District. 



CHI Health Center Omaha 346,000 sq. ft. with an 18,300-seat attached arena







If you need to be close to the convention center, sports arenas, medical centers or corporate business offices, you'll find lodging to meet your needs.




