Discover Oshkosh and Cummins are seeking a talented muralist or team of muralists to submit designs for what will become Wisconsin's largest mural to date. This project will cover the river-facing back wall of the Cummin's plant, which stretches 1,076 feet in total along the Oshkosh Riverwalk.

This project is an open call. Artists are encouraged to come up with their own concepts and designs but may want to consider both the location of the mural along the Fox River and the work that takes place inside this facility. This site is home to the first axle ever to be manufactured in the world. We are open to all designs, but the selected art should feel at home in this location.

Also, at 22' tall and 1076' long, the shape of the building must play a key roll in successful designs. The facility is visible in its entirety from both the water and the opposite bank of the river. There is also a stretch of riverwalk that runs along the river behind the facility. Cummins is working with the city to extend the green space, but mural viewers will not be able to approach the mural directly as it is on an active worksite.
