**TOUR OPTIONS:**

**The Paine Art Center** | A preserved historic mansion with art galleries and extended botanical gardens, The Paine is a favorite year-round with rotating exhibits indoor and out. It hosts the beloved Nutcracker fairytale each year with a mesmerizing array of sights, sounds and holiday surprises.

**Oshkosh Public Museum** | Gorgeous Tiffany-designed interior and windows are the perfect backdrop for a collection of art and artifacts from the region. For the holidays each room of the beautiful Sawyer home is traditionally decorated for the season, bringing history to life.

**Oshkosh Celebration of Lights** | Experience over a million twinkling lights, festive sights, and holiday sounds on a 2.4-mile drive through the EAA grounds—just off I-41. This drive-thru display features outdoor photo opportunities and a visit from Santa every night.

**The Grand Oshkosh** | Wisconsin's oldest operating opera house, built in 1883, The Grand hosts nearly 100 performances each year. Filled with holiday sounds—from Broadway stars to masters of soul, Christmastime is a "grand" experience in a majestic space. **Closed Summer of 2026 to Fall of 2027 for a \$10 million renovation and expansion project.**

**EAA Museum** | EAA Museum is the steward of aviation's past and future with a collection of more than 200 historic airplanes along with world-class galleries and displays. The museum is a year-round destination, and offers Senior, Veteran, and group rates.

**The Howard** | An artistic and historic downtown landmark, the beautifully renovated venue offers live music and theater, a boutique bowling alley, and immersive experiences, along with gourmet dining and signature drinks.

**The Morgan House** | This 1884 Queen Anne style home is a time capsule of a bygone era of Oshkosh, and is adorned in Victorian-style decorations each holiday season.

Oshkosh has a vibrant downtown area with restaurants, bars, and shops that cater to all tastes and interests, and a popular Farmers Market on Saturdays, all summer long.
