


The Howard

Seven satisfying attractions that will have you loving the outdoors.

Lake Winnebago

At nearly 132,000 acres, Lake Winnebago is the largest lake within the state. Visitors have access to the lake from numerous public boat landings and a public beach. The lake is well-known for Walleye fishing and Sturgeon spearing.

Menominee Park Zoo and Amusement Area

Located on the western shore of Lake Winnebago, this 100-acre park features an 8-acre zoo with 30-50 animals during the season, a Children's Amusement Center, paved trails, playgrounds, athletic fields and restrooms.

Terrell's Island

Terrell's Island is a 1,200-acre wetland conservation area just west of Oshkosh. There are three different trails including the popular 4-mile breakwall trail that goes out into Lake Butte des Morts.

Wiouwash Trail

The lower, 22-mile trail stretches from Oshkosh to Hortonville. Lake Butte des Morts, grassland prairies, wooded areas and farmland offer views of diverse landscapes and wildlife while the flat base makes the trail perfect for a variety of activities throughout the year.

Pollock Community Water Park

A great place to cool off during the summer, the water park features body and tube slides, zero depth entry area, lazy river, sand play area, splash pad, tot swim time in zero depth area, restroom/shower facilities and concessions. The waterpark is open June through August.

Riverwalk

The Riverwalk is a beautiful paved trail stretching for nearly two miles along both sides of the Fox River connecting Downtown Oshkosh to the Wiouwash Trail. Enjoy great views of the river and a variety of waterfront restaurants. Benches and parks along the Riverwalk offer relaxing picnic areas.

On the Loos Cruises
