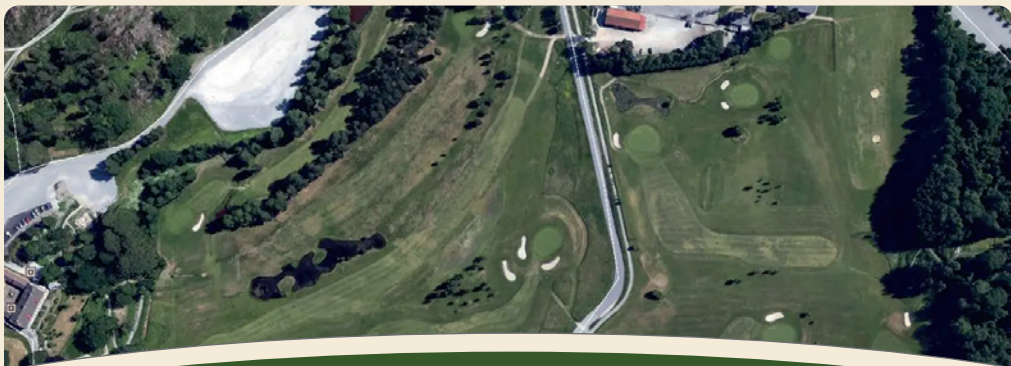

Bathing spots in Halden

- 1 **Engevika:** Lovely small sandy beach by Iddefjorden, only 2 km from the center. Along the coastal path.
- 2 **Krusetertjern.** Bathing spot with otters and nice hiking opportunities, as well as a sandy beach. Kiosk, picnic area, toilet, floating dock and diving board. Approx. 8 km north of Halden on Rv 21.
- 3 **Vanninga:** Shallow bathing spot by Femsjøen. Sandy beach and grassy area. Toilet, floating dock. Approx. 6 km north of Halden on Rv 21.
- 4 **Langholmen Ystehede:** Child friendly sandy beach, rocky outcrops, sheltered coves and grassy slopes, facing south towards Iddefjorden. Approx. 9 km south of Halden on Fv 220. Along the coastal path.
- 5 **Store Erte:** Worn rocks and newly developed sandy beach with picnic area. Toilet, floating dock. Approx. 9 km north of Halden on Rv 21.
- 6 **Svalerødkilen:** Long and nice sandy beach in Svalerødkilen, near Sponvika. Play equipment and toilet. Along the coastal path. Approx. 15 km from the center.
- 7 **Pina and Grønnbukt on Kjeøya:** Nice natural bathing spot on the west side of Kjeøya outside Sponvika. Sandy beaches and nice rocky outcrops. Outhouse, mooring dock at Pina. Several shooting trenches and nice hiking opportunities. Along the coastal path. Approx. 15 km from the center.
- 8 **Kornsjø:** At the border bridge at Kornsjø there is a bathing spot with a sandy beach, diving board and bathing dock. Here you can swim from Norway to Sweden and back if you wish. Approx. 30 km from the center.
- 9 **Ystehedenese:** Well adapted for wheelchair users and visually impaired. Bathing ramp, large picnic tables and handicap-friendly toilet. Approx. 10 km from the center.

Fredriksten fortress

HISTORY: Fredriksten fortress was built near Halden as a direct result of Norway having to cede Bohuslän and Bohus fortress to Sweden in 1658. The war continued, and during the period of 1658–1660, Swedish forces attacked Halden three times without success. Danish King Fredrik 3 then decided to build a new, modern border fortress here. The work started in 1661. The Swedes attacked the new fortress three times; in 1716, 1718, and 1814. It was never conquered in battle.

Karl XII

After a failed siege of Akershus Fortress in March–April 1716, the Swedish king Karl XII withdrew his forces from Christiania, now Oslo city, and southward to just west of Fredrikshald, which was then called Halden. Under cover of thick fog, he attacked the city and the fortress with 2000 soldiers on the night of July 4th.

The Swedes almost succeeded in taking Fredriksten by surprise, but just almost. There were terrible battles. All Norwegian soldiers stationed in the city managed to get up to the fortress, and civilians were evacuated. The Swedes captured the city, but did not enter Fredriksten. The city was prepared for burning, and in the afternoon orders were given to set selected houses on fire. Within a short time, the entire south side was in flames. The Swedes had to leave the houses and were caught in crossfire from the fortress and a cannon barge in the harbor. They had to evacuate over the partially destroyed bridge over the river to the north side. The Swedes set fire to the houses there, and under the cover of flames and smoke, they returned to their camp. In total that day, about 500 Swedish

soldiers and 180 Norwegians died. The bloodiest and worst day in Halden's long history of war. 330 houses burned down.

This story was told to Bjørnstjerne Bjørnson when he was a young journalist at a singing festival at Fredriksten in 1856. It resulted in Halden being mentioned in Norway's national anthem, as the only Norwegian city: 'Rather we let the country burn, than it fall. Just remember what happened down at Fredrikshald,' it says in the 4th verse.

The Norwegian Danish naval captain Peter Tordenskiold captured all Swedish vessels in Dynekilen on July 8th. Karl XII was then without supplies, and chose to return to Sweden with his soldiers.

In the fall of 1718, he tries again on Norway. Now with 40,000 soldiers. The king himself and about 10,000 are to take Fredriksten. They capture the small fort Gyldenløve, and dig their way towards the main fortress in trenches. In the evening of December 11th, the king climbs up on the trench edge and looks towards the fortress. He is then killed instantly by a bullet that goes straight through his head. The siege is lifted shortly after, and the Swedes go back home.

Since then, there has been discussion about whether Karl XII was assassinated

by one of his own, or hit by an 'honest Norwegian bullet'.

1814

Most people associate 1814 only with the constitution, May 17th, Eidsvoll, and Norway's freedom. But Norway had been ceded from Denmark to Sweden in January, and at the end of July a large Swedish army attacked Norway through Østfold. Fredriksten did not surrender either, and this was a contributing factor to the ceasefire agreement in Moss on August 14th. Norway then entered into a loose union with a common Swedish king, but otherwise had a high degree of self-governance. This lasted until 1905. The last shots fired in war between Scandinavian people on Scandinavian soil were at Fredriksten on the evening of August 15th, 1814.

1905

Tensions rose after the unilateral dissolution of the Norwegian union on June 7th. Both countries mobilized their forces, and the fear of war was great. Norway had just modernized its defense to one of the most advanced in the world, and Fredriksten had received many new and powerful cannons. Fortunately, a peaceful dissolution of the union was negotiated, but one of the Swedish demands was that all new weapons had to be removed from Fredriksten. This was accepted, and everything was dismantled by 1906. Fredriksten had been a significant contribution to Norway's independence, without a single shot being fired in war. Many believe that this is the pinnacle of the importance Fredriksten has had in 250 years of Norwegian history.

Fredriksten today

Fredriksten as a memorial, tourist destination and cultural arena

Fredriksten is Norway's largest, most important and most honorable border fortress. Yes, it is even the most important fortress in Swedish history! Many believe that it is one of the most beautiful in Europe, as it majestically towers over Halden.

Did you know that the spectacular side facing the city is actually the back side? The front faces east, towards the road to Sweden.

Fredriksten is an impressive complex with the Main Fortress, 3 smaller forts on the east side, and Borgerskansen on the city side. The entire area is over 600 acres in size. There are 20,000 m² of wall surfaces and 40 larger buildings, but also plenty of nature, from lawns and well-kept parks to almost untouched mixed forests. Over 10 km of trails and roads, and a wide biological diversity. You can experience the history through modern IT solutions on your own phone, on a large number of signs placed around, or join one of our knowledgeable guides on an educational walk. Here you will find the Fredriksten Museum, Information Center with a shop, dining options, children's activities, viewpoints, benches to rest on, toilets, – and free parking.

Around 300,000 people visit the fortress every year. Many of these come to participate in one or more of the many events here. There are large concerts and festivals, Norway's largest outdoor opera, car exhibitions, cycling races, Christmas markets – and much more, big and small.

Fredriksten Fortress – walking through history

Fredriksten Fortress – from the country's most important defense fortification to one of the country's most spectacular cultural arenas. A living history for over 350 years.

From being Norway's most important defense structure, Fredriksten is now a popular tourist area and an international event venue. Events such as Bilsport Classic Grensetreffet, By the Border festival, Grenserittet, and Opera at Fredriksten take place in the same areas that have been used for drills, exercises, and punishment.

But beware - history is never far away. Who actually shot Karl XII? What happened to the prisoners who tried to escape from the fortress? What eerie apparition might show itself at the Clock Tower at midnight? ...?

Outdoor life in Halden



More attractions:



Halden offers fantastic hiking areas in the city center as well as in the surrounding forests, where you can enjoy nature experiences on foot, by bike, or in a canoe. The city is home to many outdoor enthusiasts, reflected in the numerous sports cabins that are open to the public. Some of these cabins are located near illuminated trails, making them perfect starting points for adventures with friends and family. Ormtjernhytta in Halden is a particularly exciting spot to explore, with an abundance of plant life, animals, insects, and even creatures from fairy tales waiting to be discovered.



Troll Path

1–2 km | Family

A family friendly hiking trail around Ormtjern, with trolls and adventure figures in and around the path. Easy forest terrain. It is recommended to leave the stroller behind and use a baby carrier for the smallest children.



Brekke–Nestangen

4,5 km | Easy

The hike starts at Europe's highest lock facility. From Brekke, cross the bridge and follow the path along the water and into the forest. Walk through Søndre Brekke farm and follow the path to Nesbukta and further to Nestangen.



Skriverøya–Ystehedeneset

4 km | Family

Historical monuments, easy hiking trails, and great views over Iddefjorden. The hike can be extended by going into the forest at Ystehedeneset and following the ridge northwards, and eventually westwards, back towards the parking lot.



Engevika

5 km | Easy

A magnificent hike from the city center to Halden's city beach. The hike goes through Sørhalden with colorful wooden houses, through cultivated fields in Eskeviken, to dense forest out to Iddefjorden and Engevika.



Hjelmkollen

1 km | Easy

Easily accessible viewpoint at Hjelmkollen. Allow 15 minutes to reach the top and 10 minutes to go back down. The view is fantastic towards Halden, the old and new Svinesund bridges, and Hvaler.

Did you know that...

- the name Halden comes from the Old Norse 'hallr' or 'høll', which means hill or slope? The city is surrounded by a landscape that slopes towards the center.
- the city was founded in 1665 and was named Fredrikshald in honor of King Fredrik III? Halden is Norway's oldest industrial city and played a prominent role as a maritime city in the 19th century.
- from the late 19th century to the 1960s, Halden was also known as Norway's shoe capital? In the late 1950s, every fifth shoe in Norway was produced in Halden.
- Halden is also known as the place where the Swedish warrior king Karl XII fell, at 9:30 pm on December 11, 1718? There is a monument on Stevnesletta at Fredriksten Fortress marking the spot where Karl XII was shot.
- the people of Halden are proud that the city is the only one mentioned in the national anthem? The fourth verse says: 'For we would rather burn the land than see it fall; just remember what happened down at Fredrikshald!' This refers to the event in 1716 when the people of Halden set fire to the city to prevent Karl XII from taking control during the first Norwegian campaign.
- the first Jarlsberg cheese was produced at Halden Meieri in Brødløs?
- Halden is known for its sweet buns? These can be enjoyed even by vegetarians. Buns are sweet, large, flat buns with a hole in the middle.



- Erlandsens Conditori is Norway's oldest bakery, established in 1865.
- there are four border crossings in Halden? These include Svinesund – both the new and old bridge, Berby/Tyslingmoen, Holtet and Kornsjø.
- Halden has a rich cultural life to offer. Here you can explore one of Norway's most beautiful wooden house environments and experience unique architecture from the 1800s? The Empire City was built with inspiration from Napoleon's heyday.
- The Conservative, Rød Herregård, Halden's Club and Fredrikshald Theater with Norway's oldest preserved baroque stage, are cultural treasures you can explore here.
- you can also participate in events such as Grensetreffet, Grenserittet, The International Music Film Festival and performances by Opera Østfold and The Norwegian Wind Ensemble.
- Europe's highest lock staircase can be found in the Halden Canal? Brekke locks are 100 years old this year!
- in Halden you can also walk Europe's longest suspension bridge in Via Ferrata – Via Ferrata Halden Canal.

Shop in Halden

In the center of historic Halden, you will find many cozy, picturesque small shops. The city's main shopping street stretches from the pedestrian street by the beautiful Busterud Park in the north, over the footbridge and to the venerable square on the south side. In the center, along the river Tista, you will find the Tista Center shopping mall, which has 45 stores. In Halden center, you will find everything you need, and the city center is not larger than that you can easily walk from one end to the other.

Europe's most beautiful border crossing!

Visste du følgende om den gamle brua:

- The old Svinesund bridge was completed in 1946 and is 420 meters long and 65 meters high
- Previously, there was a ferry that crossed the strait
- The old bridge had different names on the Norwegian and Swedish sides; in Norway it was called 'Brunr. 1–109 Svinesund'. In Sweden, it was called 'Bro 06 over Idefjorden at Svinesund (Svinesundsbron) in Strömstad on road E6'
- Locally, the old bridge was simply called 'Svinesundbrua' and 'Svinesundsbron'
- From archaeological excavations, we know that there have been settlements in the area since the Stone Age, around 3500 BC
- Svinesund is described in several sagas from the Viking Age.
- The old bridge Svinesundbroen has been protected by the National Heritage Board, who believed that the bridge is a symbol of the connection between Norway and Sweden

The Svinesund bridges have become a well-known landmark and have received recognition for both design and construction. Both bridges are different in construction and appearance. This view can be seen from Hjelmkollen Fort. The view from the bridges and the surrounding valley sides down to the fjord is alone worth a visit! Here, you will be impressed by the magnificent view of the landscape, the beautiful fjord, and the sea. Come and see for yourself!

Did you know the following about the new bridge:

- Construction of the new bridge started in 2003
- The new bridge was built right next to the old one
- On the Norwegian side lies Halden and on the Swedish side lies Strömstad
- The fjord under the bridge is the only one in Norway with multiple names: at the outermost part, it is called Singlefjorden, then Ringdalsfjorden, and at the innermost part, it is called Iddefjorden.
- The fjord also has different names on the Swedish and Norwegian sides.
- The bridge was opened by King Harald and King Carl Gustaf in 2005.
- The new Svinesund bridge is 704 meters long and 92 meters high.

Brekke Locks 100 years

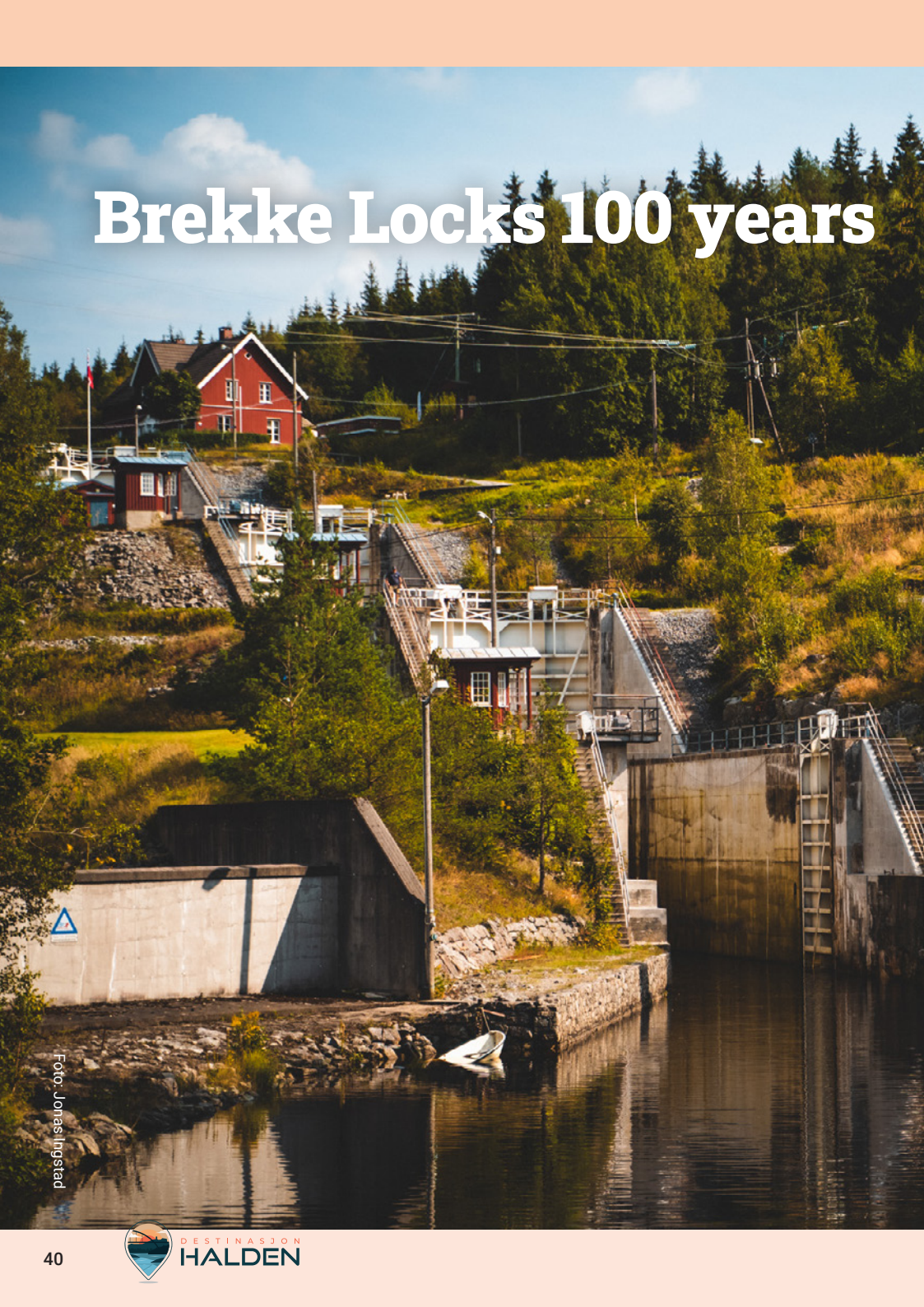

Brekke Locks and the Halden Canal

Brekke Locks – an impressive lock system located in the Halden Canal, is celebrating its 100th anniversary this year. With a total lifting height of 26.6 meters spread over four chambers, Brekke Locks is Europe's highest continuous lock staircase. The Halden Canal with its lock systems was constructed under the leadership of Engebret Soot. The facility in Brekke was destroyed by a flood in 1861 and rebuilt in 1877.

The lock system, as it stands today, was completed in 1924. At that time, the waterfalls in Stenselva were collected in Brekke locks and Krappeto was dammed, resulting in the water level being raised by 14 meters. At the same time, Brekke Power Plant was also completed. Timber transportation used to dominate the waterways, but this changed in 1982 when timber trucks took over.

Today, Brekke Locks is not only a historic landmark, but also a popular tourist destination along the Halden Canal. Visitors can experience the locking process that takes place daily during the summer season, with set lock times.

If you want to experience the thrill of being locked up and down in a canoe, you can rent one on site and explore the canal on your own. MS Brekke operates on a regular route throughout the summer, including locking. Adventurous visitors can also try Via Ferrata and cross the canal via zipline at the locks. There is the possibility of overnight accommodation in the coastal cabin Fløtærhytta and in the Lock Assistant's residence nearby. Guest docks and a camper parking area provide opportunities for visitors with boats or RVs. In addition, there are several beautiful hiking trails near Brekke Locks. Take a break from everyday life and enjoy the nature in the area, whether it's by relaxing in shelters or spending the night under the open sky at one of the campsites.

Join Brekke Locks' 100th anniversary celebration throughout the summer, and visit the locks that have been an important part of Halden's history for many years.

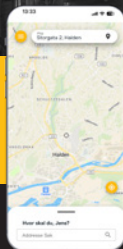
