

SHORT TERM RESTRICTED FUND REIMBURSEMENT CRITERION

Before requesting project reimbursement the below items must be completed. A project is complete once the following items have been executed:

Signage or Pre-approved Recognition:	On appropriate capital projects the Dare County Tourism Board encourages alternative to basic signage, for example – bench on multi-use path. All signage must include the official Dare County Tourism Board logo and the following recognition to the benefactor " <i>Project Funded In Part By The Dare County Tourism Board</i> " and the name of the project. A photo of the installed sign must be included in the Reimbursement Package.
Accounting:	Provide complete accounting records, including original invoices, copies of cancelled checks, payrolls, and contracts.
Site Inspection:	A site inspection will be made in order to verify signage and completion of project.
Reimbursement:	Financial contribution of the Outer Banks Visitors Bureau will be made to organization, upon completion of project – and on the last day of each quarter (September, December, March, June).
Reimbursement will be DENIED if the official logo of the Dare County Tourism Board, the following recognition to the benefactor " <i>This Project Funded In Part By The Dare County Tourism Board</i> ", and project name is not included on all signage. Camera-ready logo will be provided free of charge to all grantees.
