

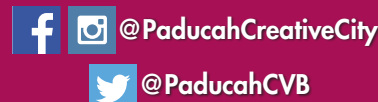

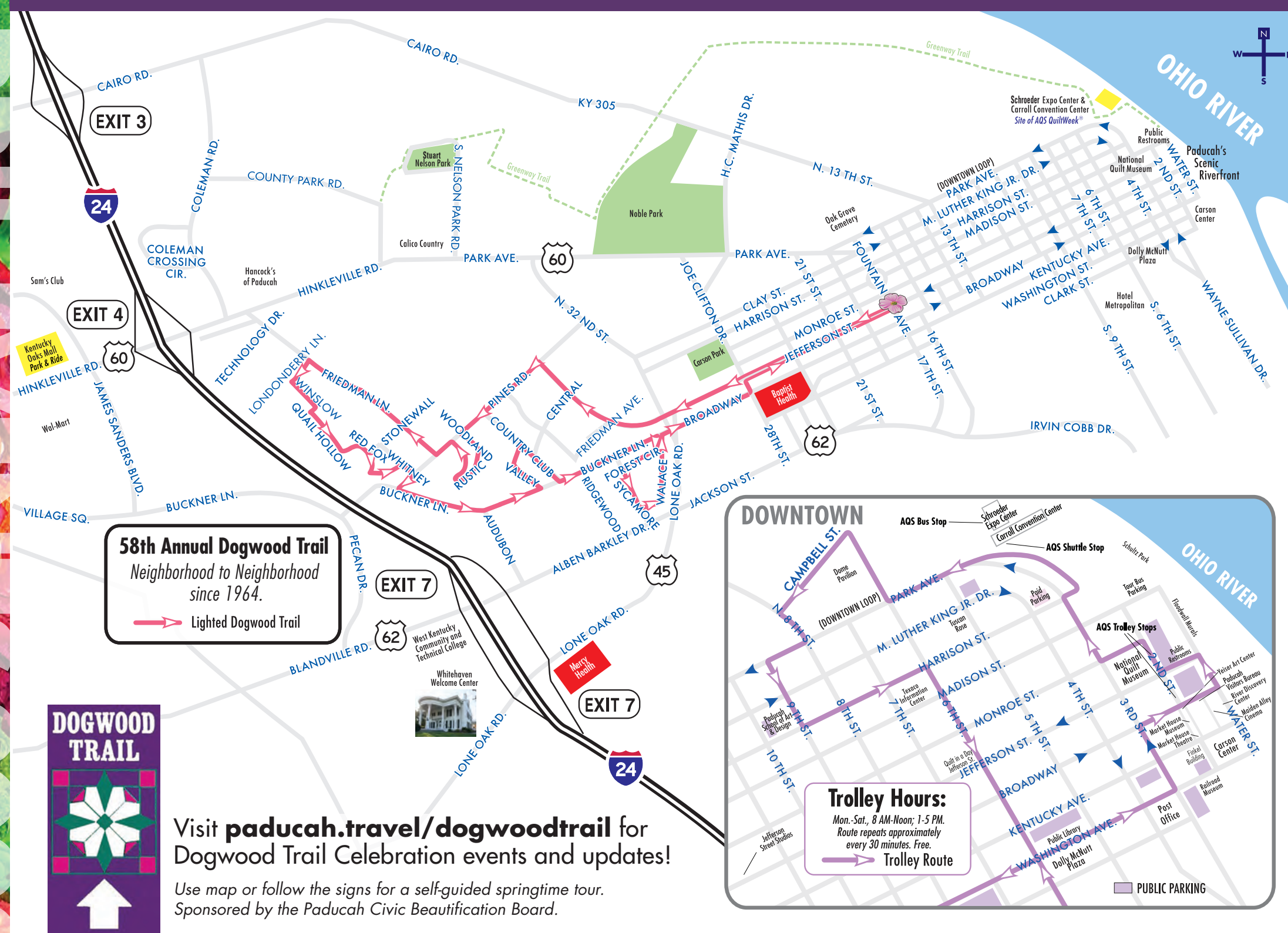

### Getting Around Town

Historic Downtown Paducah is a walkable area with ample free parking available in close proximity to the various AQS QuiltWeek venues. Acquaint yourself with public parking locations, shuttle route schedules and transportation services at [paducah.travel/quiltweek](http://paducah.travel/quiltweek) or in the AQS Show Book.

- **Shuttle Routes:** Complimentary shuttle service is provided by participating hotels and attractions, the Paducah Visitors Bureau and AQS. Shuttle routes and authorized stops are published in the AQS Show Book and at [paducah.travel/quiltweek](http://paducah.travel/quiltweek).

- **Park & Ride:** Park at Kentucky Oaks Mall, 5101 Hinkleville Rd. at I-24 Exit 4 and ride the Shuttle to and from the AQS Shuttle Stop and Kentucky Oaks Mall. Look for AQS Shuttle Stop signage adjacent to Best Buy.

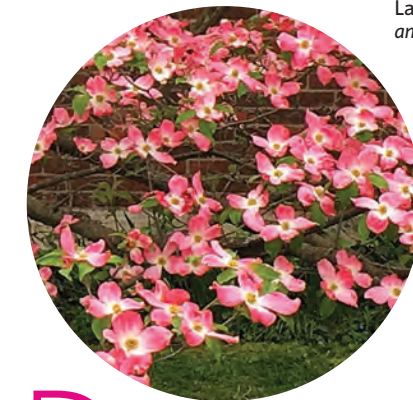
