

History Comes to Life

Listed in the Green Book, the Hotel Metropolitan was once a famous stop for African American entertainers and luminaries — including Louis Armstrong, B.B. King, Ella Fitzgerald, Ike and Tina Turner, and Thurgood Marshall — throughout the 20th century before desegregation. Now a "Save America's Treasures" project, this gorgeously restored 1908 hotel invites guests to hear the stories of those who stayed within its walls through Ms. Maggie's Memories, a living history presentation named in honor of the hotel's founder, Ms. Maggie Steed.




