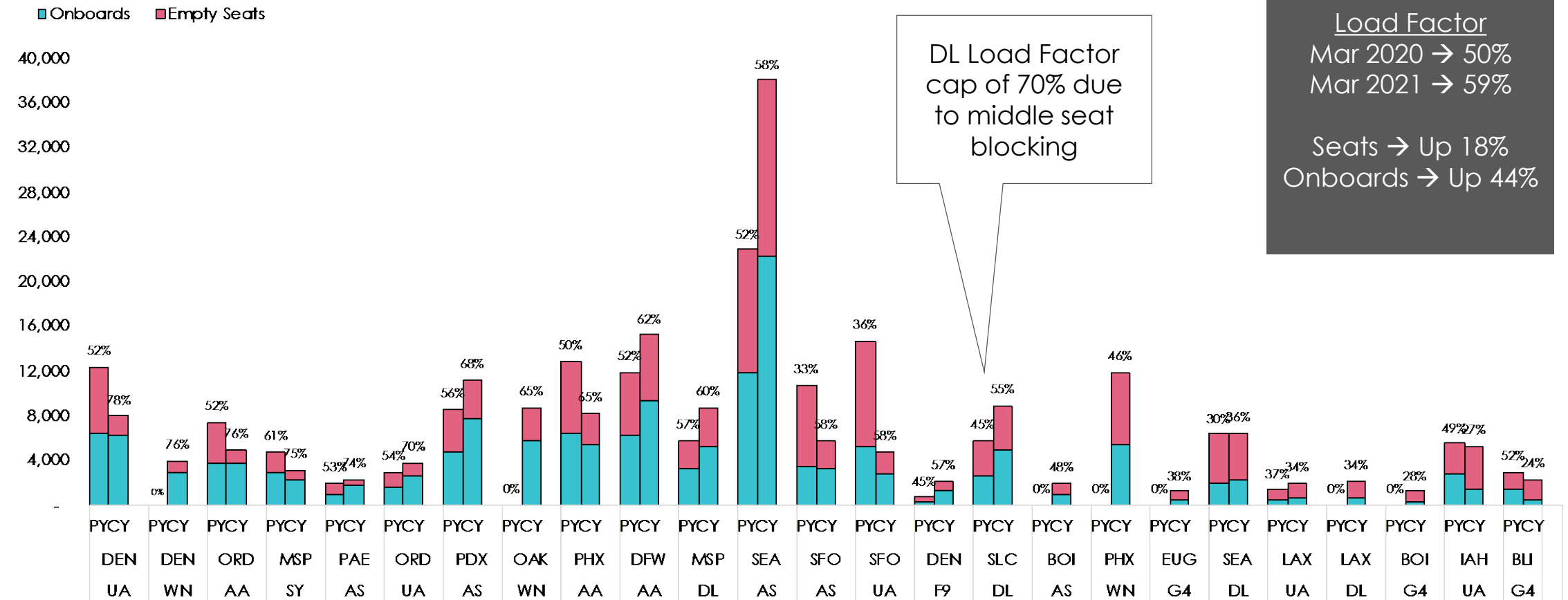


# MARCH 2021 ONBOARD TRAFFIC WAS UP 44% ON TOP OF A 18% INCREASE IN SEATS

Monthly onboards + monthly empty seats: March 2020 (PY) vs. March 2021 (CY)



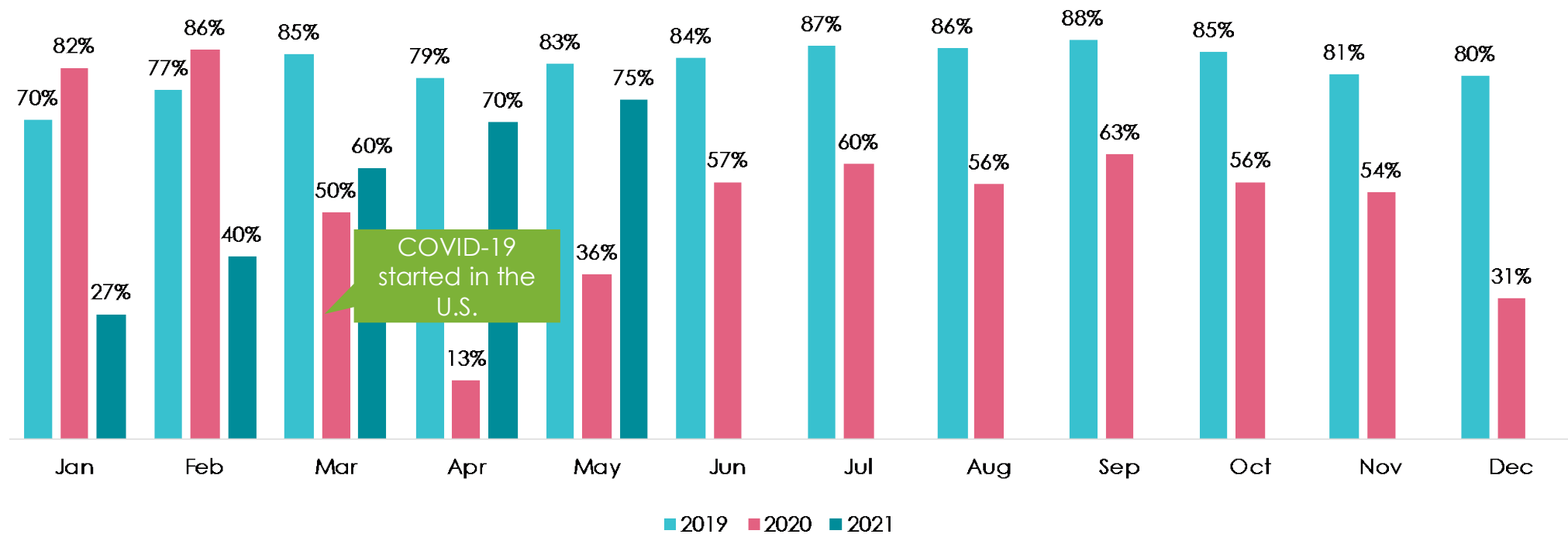

## PSP LOAD FACTOR BY MONTH

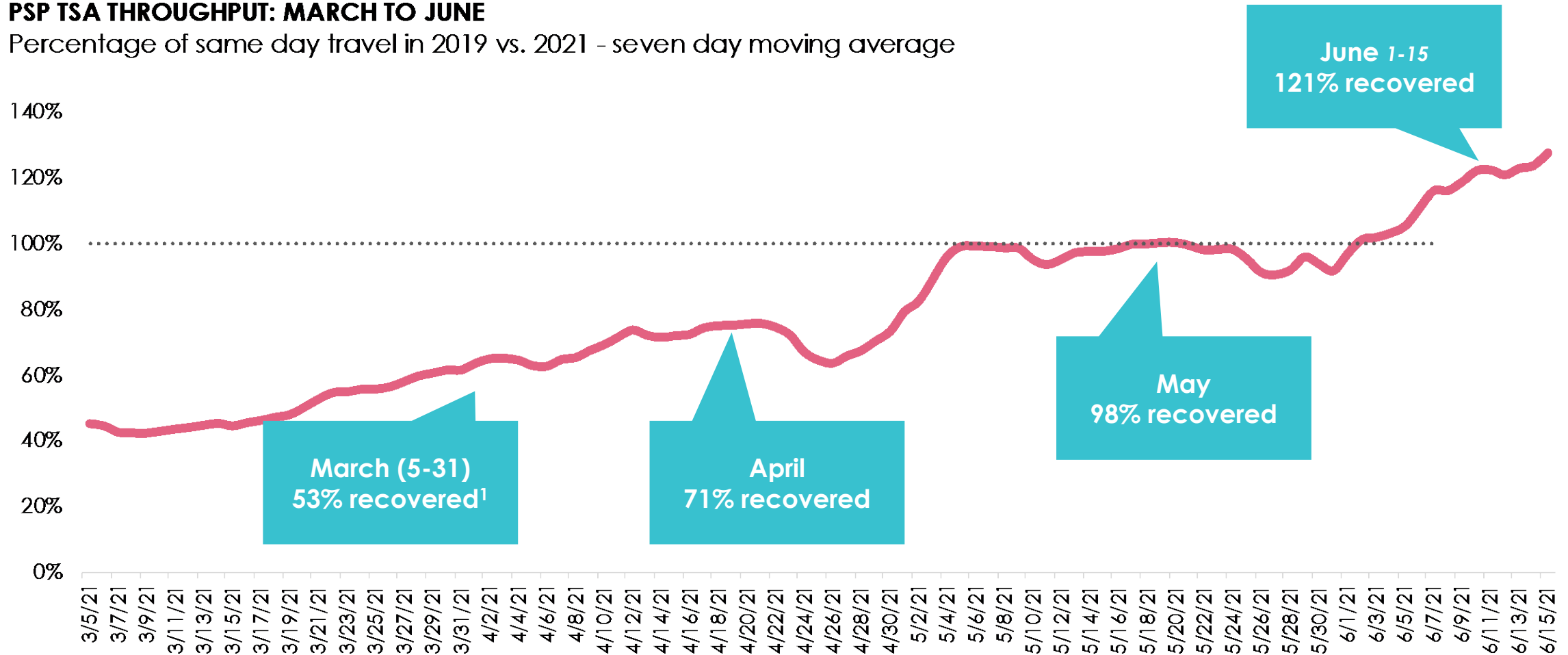
Load Factor: January 2019 to May 2021

Percentage of same day travel in 2019 vs. 2021 - seven day moving average



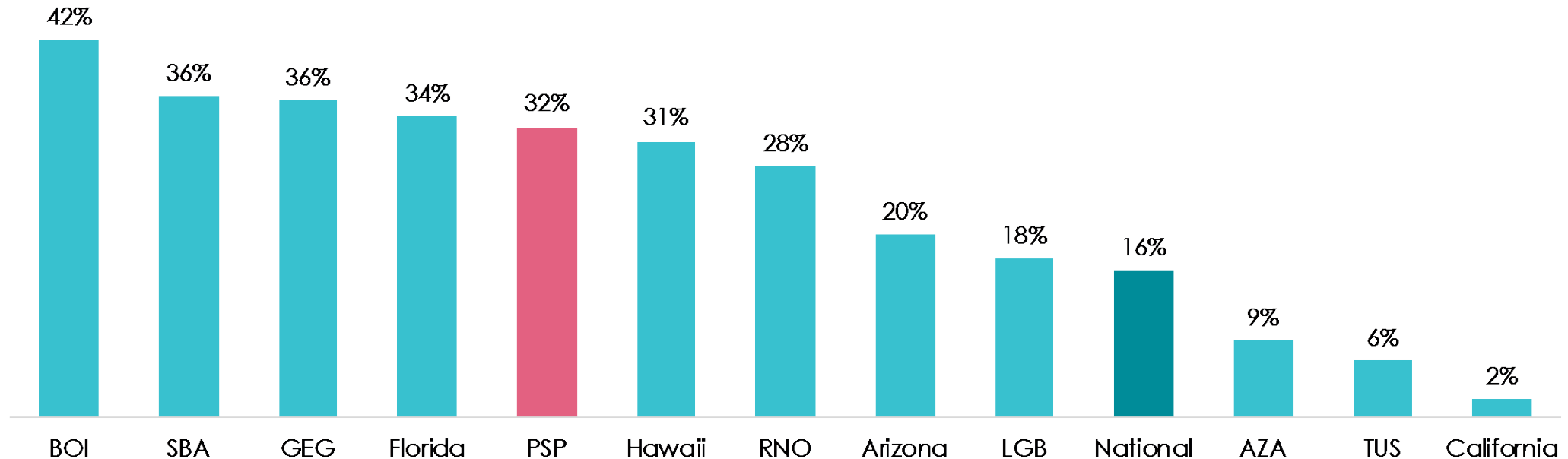

## PSP VS. PEERS: PERCENTAGE OF SEATS FROM 1H 2020 TO 1H 2021

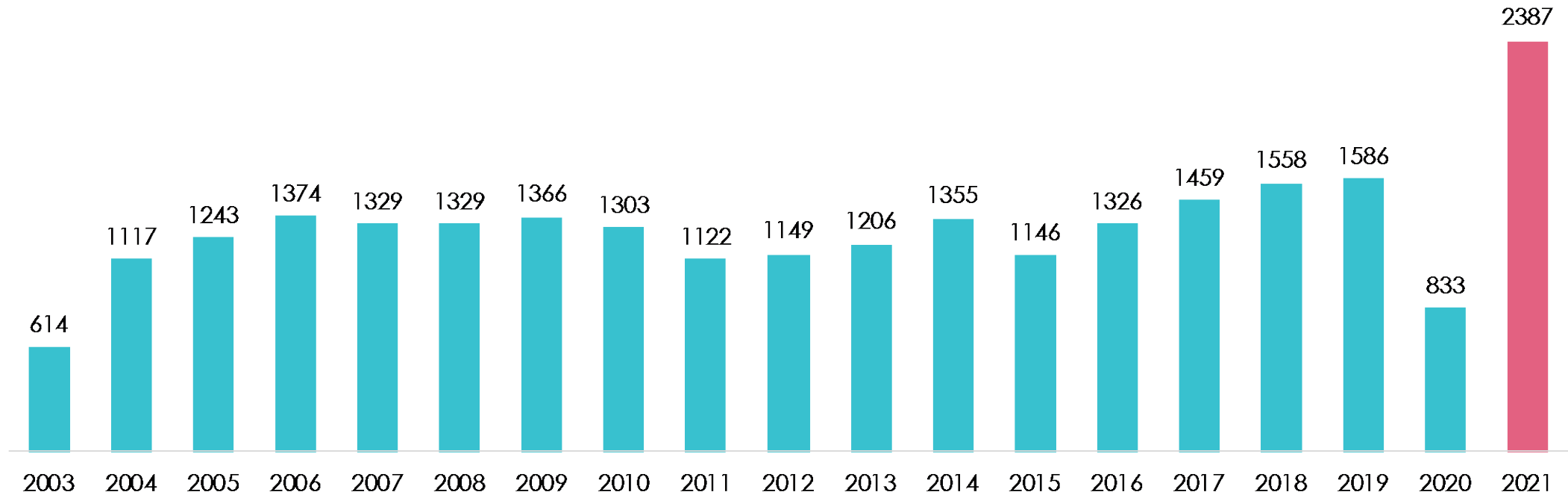
January 2020 to August 2020 vs. January 2021 to August 2021

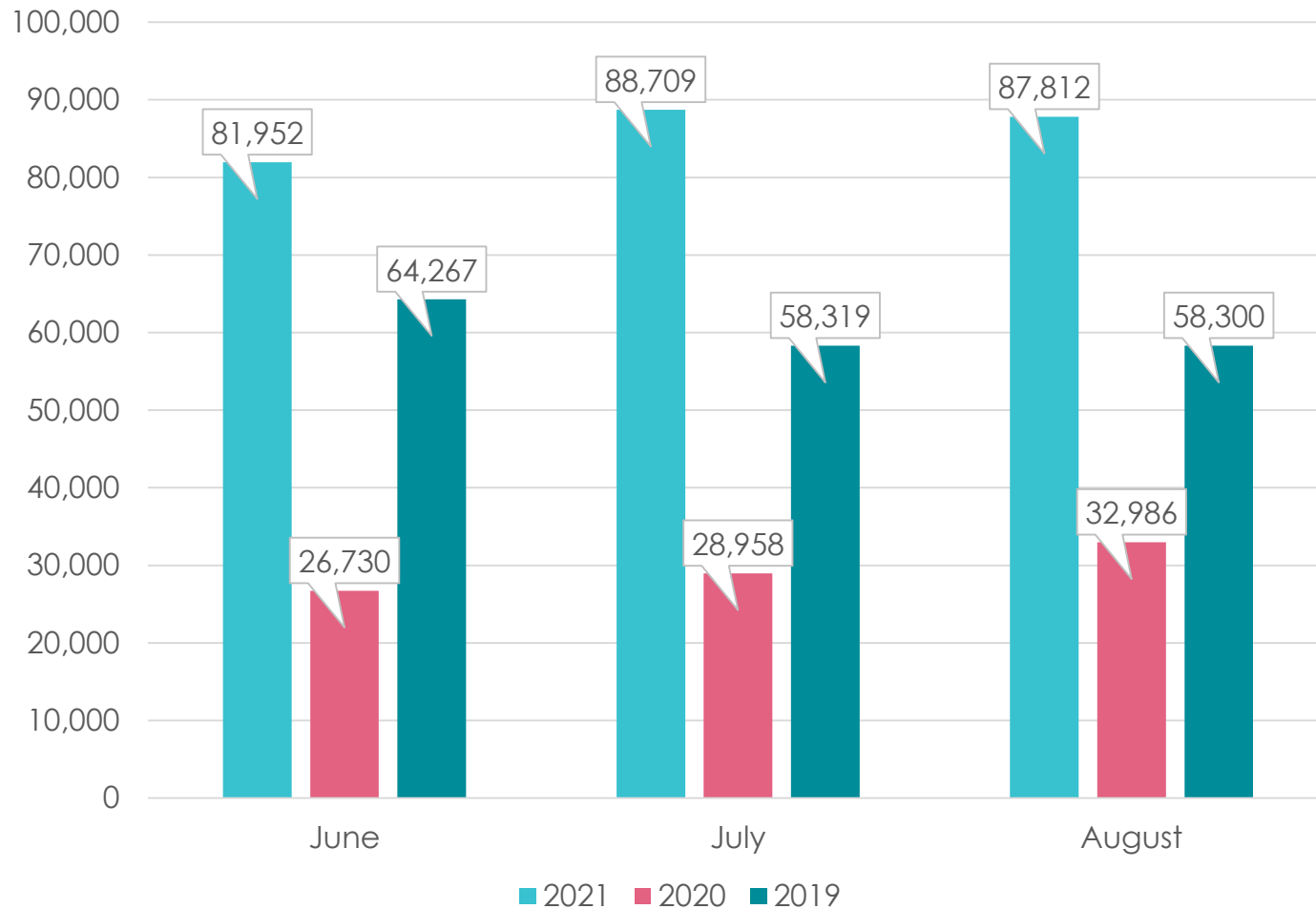
## PSP SUMMER DAILY SEAT CAPACITY TRENDS

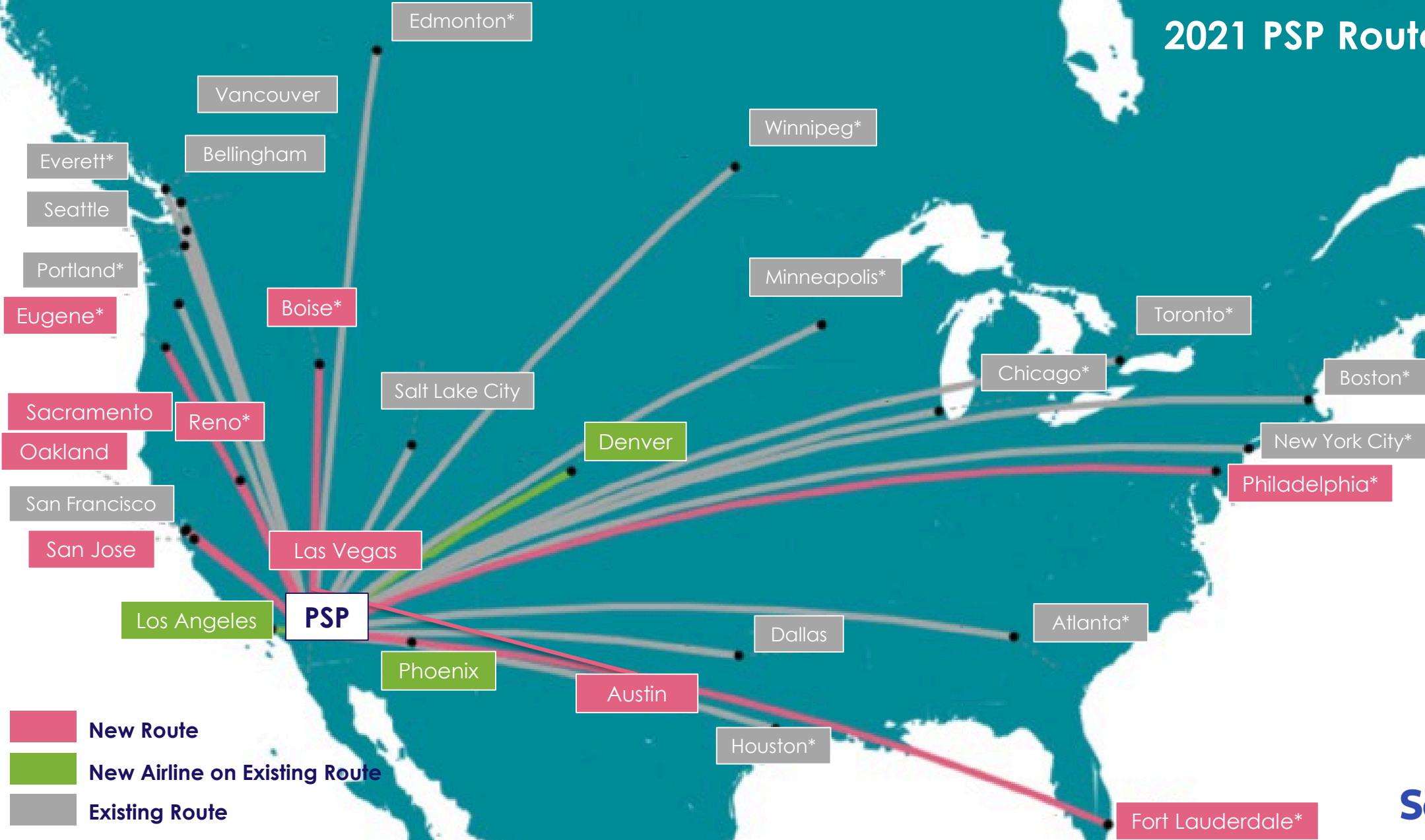
