

Number of one-way onboards: 2016 to 2022*



PSP DOMESTIC MARKETS - LOAD FACTOR²

PSP Onboards were up 8% due to a 8% increase in seat capacity resulting in load factor of 87%;
2 points higher than 2019



PSP'S HIGHEST LOAD FACTOR MARKETS IN APRIL WERE AMERICAN'S CHICAGO & DELTA'S ATLANTA & MINNEAPOLIS SERVICE

April 2019 versus April 2022

PSP Onboards were up 23% due to a 20% decrease in seat capacity resulting in load factor of 83%; 4 points higher than 2019



PSP Onboards were up 28% due to a 28% decrease in seat capacity resulting in load factor of 83%; consistent with 2019





Load Factor: 2019 versus 2020 versus 2021 versus 2022



Daily hotel occupancy rates (%): January 1, 2022 to September 3, 2022



Monthly seats in thousands, September to December 2019 versus 2022





PSP WILL WELCOME AVELO AIRLINES THIS WINTER SEASON



MANY SEASONAL ROUTES ARE RETURNING EARLIER THIS FALL THAN IN PREVIOUS YEARS

Air Canada resuming Toronto (YYZ) on October 1ST (historically resumed in late December)

Air Canada resuming Vancouver (YVR) on October 2nd (historically resumed in late October)

Alaska resuming Boise (BOI) on November 20th (historically resumed in mid December)

American resuming Chicago (ORD) on September 7th (historically resumed in early October)

Delta resuming Minneapolis (MSP) on October 16th (historically resumed in mid December)

JetBlue's New York (JFK) flight projected to be 1x daily in November & December (historically 4-5x per week during these two monghts)

United resuming Chicago (ORD) on September 30th (historically resumed in late October)
