

desert hot springs



Located in the foothills just north of Palm Springs, Desert Hot Springs is best known for its natural underground hot mineral water streams that feed into its multiple spa properties. The city's unique geology has made it a world famous destination for relaxation and rejuvenation.

- Fun Facts**
- Desert Hot Springs' more than 20 boutique mineral water spa resorts and hideaways have earned it the nickname: "California's Spa City."
 - Cabo's Pueblo Museum, one of Desert Hot Springs' unique treasures, is a Hopi-inspired pueblo in the heart of Desert Hot Springs, hand-created from reclaimed and found objects throughout the surrounding area.

cathedral city



Cathedral City is a center of family oriented fun, unique dining, hiking and special events, from the annual Hot Air Balloon Festival to Art Fairs. People from around the world come to visit the award-winning Fountain of Life in Cathedral City's Town Square, the site of many festivals and events.

- Fun Facts**
- The city's Mary Pickford Theater houses a Mary Pickford museum featuring personal belongings and costumes of the world famous silent screen star.
 - Sports and family fun include Big League Dreams Sports Park while ice skaters and hockey players enjoy Desert Ice Castle.
 - The Festival Lawn is the home of on-going and special events in Downtown Cathedral City between the Mary Pickford Theatre and the Desert Cinemas UltraMAX.

palm springs



A combination of perfect weather, Hollywood glamour and an intimate village atmosphere keeps Palm Springs on the A-list of great destinations. Visitors enjoy fine dining, shopping and renowned, unique hotels amid a celebrated midcentury modern architecture. Art, culture and many special annual events, such as the Palm Springs International Film Festival, put the city on the map.

- Fun Facts**
- The Palm Springs Aerial Tramway, with rotating tramcars, takes visitors on one of the steepest ascents in the world to elevation 8,200 feet and 54 miles of hiking trails. The 10-minute ride to the top reveals 30-degree temperature drops, as well as winter snow.
 - Every Thursday night, vibrant Palm Canyon Drive is transformed into VillageFest, an outdoor festival of food, music, arts and crafts and more.
 - The Palm Springs Indian Canyons are filled with trails for hiking or horseback riding, lush oases, natural water formations and historic remnants of the early Agua Caliente Band of Indians who inhabited the area.

rancho mirage



Unique for its designation as the "Playground of Presidents," Rancho Mirage's stellar golf courses, lushly landscaped estates, first-class shopping and fine dining remind visitors why the likes of Frank Sinatra, Lucille Ball and President Ford and former First Lady Betty Ford chose to call this city home.

- Fun Facts**
- Sunnylands, the former estate of US Ambassador Walter Annenberg and his wife Leonore, is open to the public. Admission to the Sunnylands Visitor Center & Gardens is free, while tours of the estate and special events are offered at select times with advance ticket reservations.
 - The River entertainment complex, Children's Discovery Museum and Tolerance Education Center are just a few of the visitor highlights located in Rancho Mirage.
 - The SHOW concert theater, a \$75 million high-tech, 2,000-seat headliner showroom at Agua Caliente Casino Resort Spa features major entertainers throughout the year.

palm desert



Palm Desert is a cultural, educational and retail center featuring the "Rodeo Drive of the Desert"—El Paseo. The city also claims the renowned McCallum Theatre, The Living Desert, excellent hiking trails, beautiful golf resorts and shopping for every taste.

- Fun Facts**
- The nation's only citywide Golf Cart Parade is held in Palm Desert each October, drawing about 25,000 spectators who watch more than 100 creatively decorated golf carts travel down El Paseo.
 - College of the Desert Street Fair, a collection of clothing, crafts, food, music and vendors, is held in Palm Desert each Saturday and Sunday morning.
 - The Palm Springs Art Museum in Palm Desert features ongoing and temporary exhibitions of internationally recognized art in different media.
 - On "First Weekends of the Month," November-May, the city offers art walks and an assortment of entertainment, from gallery exhibits to a popular cruise night.


