PREPARING FOR ARRIVAL

- Please keep in mind that protective face coverings are currently required by the state of California both indoors and outdoors when you are within 6 feet of someone else or a business.
- For your safety and well-being, we may limit the number of people gathered together and split into multiple groups for the site tours.
- During the site tour, we will only use elevators if needed, with no more than 3 people per elevator.
- Rest assured that all staff and partners (hotels, venues, attractions and restaurants) will be following the proper health and safety protocols mandated by city and state ordinances throughout your visit.
