The Field is Set for the PCB College Baseball Classic

Tournament Play Coming February 2023

[PANAMA CITY BEACH, Fla.] November 21, 2022 – Gulf Coast State College and Publix Sports Park (PCB) will be hosting the second annual Panama City Beach College Baseball Classic in Panama City Beach, FL, February 3-5, 2023.

The PCB College Baseball Classic will be a three-day preseason tournament. This tournament will consist of 16 of the top junior college baseball teams from around the country. Seven of these teams finished the 2022 season ranked in the top 20. Three players who participated in last year's tournament were drafted in the first four rounds of the 2022 Major League Baseball Draft.

"We are thrilled to partner with GCSC and Visit Panama City Beach to bring the PCB College Baseball Classic back for a second year. This is a great opportunity to see top-level majorleague prospects first-hand," says Mike Higgins, General Manager of Publix Sports Park. Gulf Coast State College will once again serve as the tournament host. "The Panama City Beach College Baseball Classic is a great opportunity for us and the other schools to play highlevel competition at a great venue. This tournament will be extremely competitive as Wabash Valley College, San Jacinto College, and McLennan Community College played in the 2022 JUCO World Series.
