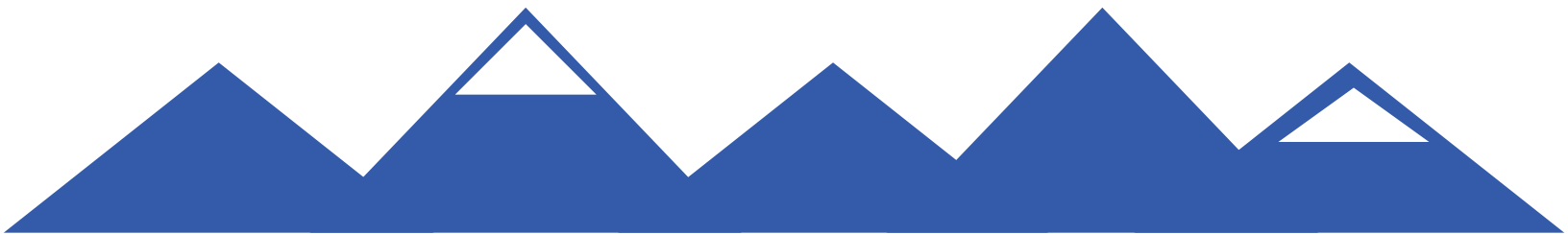

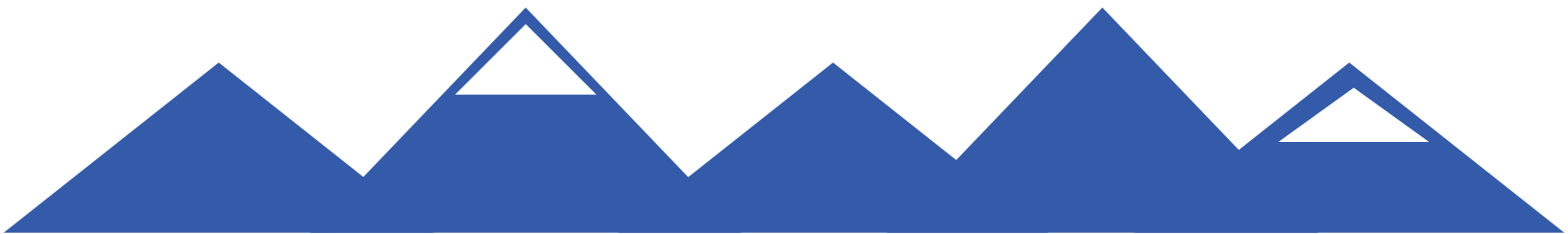

MOST ACCESSIBLE MOUNTAIN DESTINATION

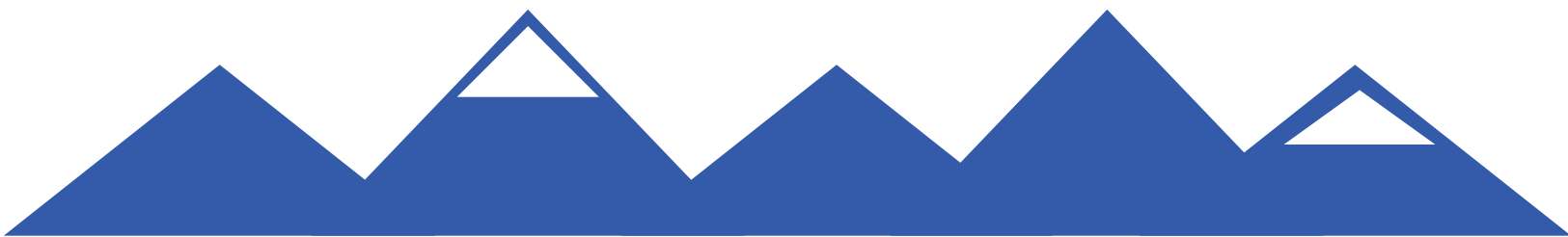
Flying into Utah? Be sure to linger in the all-new [Salt Lake City International Airport](#) which became America's newest air terminal when it opened in September 2020!

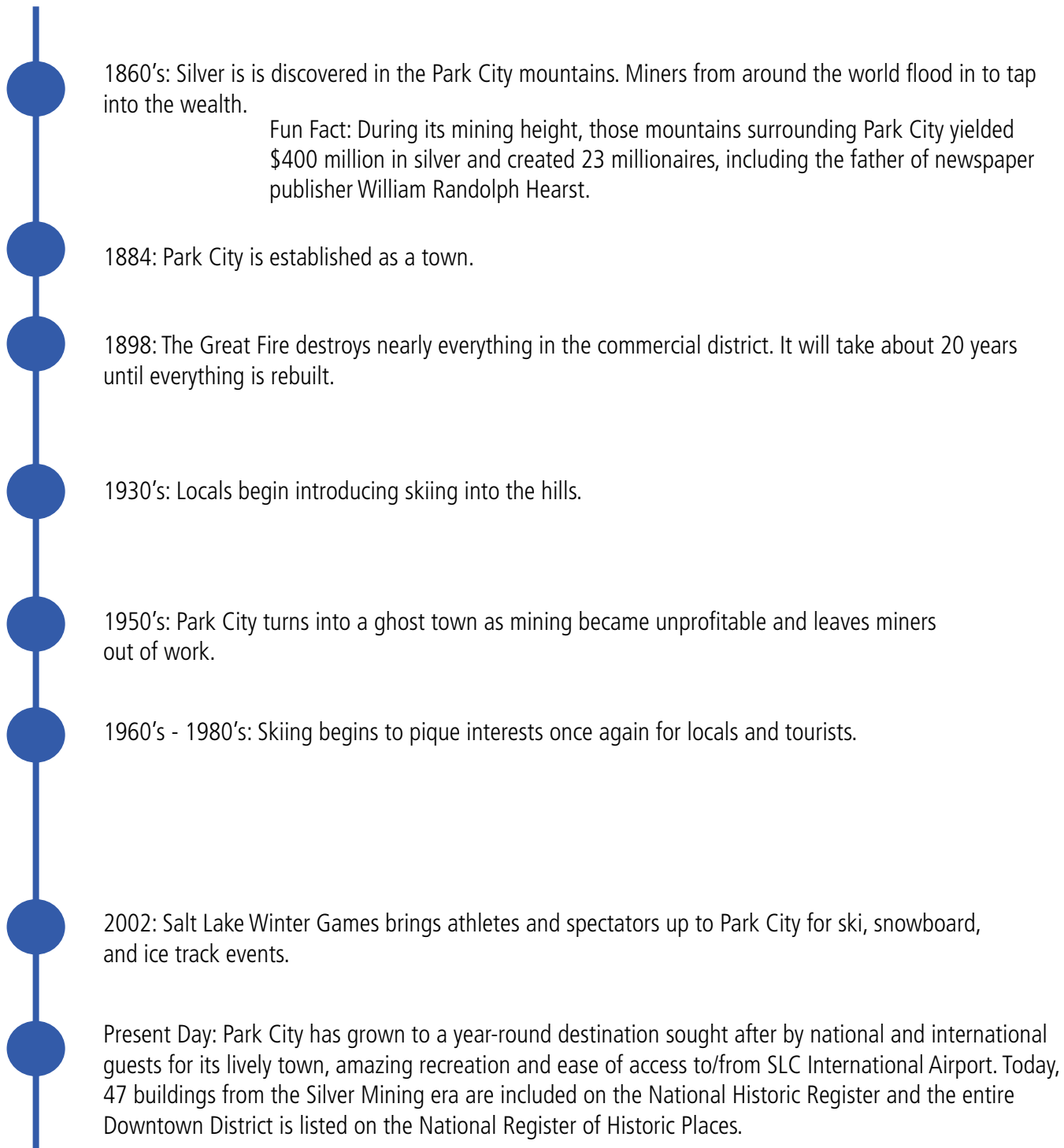
