




30-Year Mortgage Rates Still Below Average














Fed Shrinking Its Balance Sheet





GDP Slowed in the First Quarter




U.S. Job Growth Slowed in April




Most Industries Expanded in April

Monthly Job Change by Industry (In Thousands)




Unemployment Increased in April





Labor Force Participation Rate Unchanged in April








Consumer Prices Up 20% Since 2020

- Services (excluding energy and housing)




Note: Prepandemic trend is average from January 2011 to January 2020. Core PCE is the price index of personal-consumption expenditures, excluding food and energy.

Twelve-month change in personal-consumption expenditures index




Figure 2: Aggregate excess savings following onset of recessions






Personal Saving Rate Lower than Before COVID



Delinquent Debt Increasing As Consumers Get Tapped Out




CPI Inflation: 2000-2024








Large Differences in State Population Growth










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Utah Employment Growth Above U.S.






Most Utah Industries Grew Over the Past Year

February 2023 to 2024




Utah Unemployment Among Lowest in the Nation





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Utah Unemployment Rates By County March 2024 State Rate = 2.8%


- 1. Federal Reserve rate cuts?
