Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 5.3% since 2017, growing by 2,196. Population is expected to increase by 4.9% between 2022 and 2027, adding 2,116.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs increased by 5.6% in Summit County, UT from 28,782 to 30,385. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 2.4% by 3.2%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 82.6% to 79.3% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **35.3% of Summit County, UT residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (14.5% above the national average), and **4.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (4.0% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Other Amusement and Recreation Industries, Restaurants and Other Eating Places, and Traveler Accommodation.







Unemployment by Gender








Population Trends





Unemployment Rate Trends


Summit County, UT had a December 2022 unemployment rate of 1.62%, decreasing from 3.02% 5 years before.










Top Growing Industries




Top Industry Location Quotient
