# MUST BE ORIGINAL AND UNEXPIRED DOCUMENTS (2 or more may be required, 1 must include photo)

## **ALL US CITIZENS BORN IN THE STATES**

**Drivers License or State Issued ID** 

- \*U.S. Passport
- \*Birth Certificate

\* - As of January  $1^{st}$ , 2012 all citizens born in the U.S. must provide either a U.S. Passport or Birth Certificate at time of fingerprinting. A Social Security Card is no longer acceptable as a primary form of ID.

### NATURALIZED CITIZENS BORN ABROAD

Drivers License or State Issued ID U.S. Passport Certificate of Naturalization Certification of Birth Abroad (FS-545, FS-240, and DS-1350)

#### NON-U.S. CITIZENS

Drivers License or State Issued ID/ Valid Permanent Resident Card Valid Employment Authorization Card Employment Authorization which is stamped in current country of Citizenship passport

These documents are used to establish Identity and Employment eligibility per SD 1542-04-08G
